

ANSTRUTHER

OF THAT ILK

WILLIAM DE CANDELA, LORD OF ANSTRUTHER, was in possession of the lands of Anstruther in the last years of the 12th century although of consequence is known of him, nor of his origins and ancestry. He was father of :

WILLIAM DE CANDELA, LORD OF ANSTRUTHER, styled as “filius Williemi de Candela dominus de Anstruther” when he made a donation to the Abbey of Balmerino.¹ He was father of :

HENRY DE ANSTRUTHER, confirmed his father’s donation to the Abbey of Balmerino which was confirmed by King Alexander II. in the seventh year of his reign, 1221.² He was father of :

HENRY DE ANSTRUTHER, who made a donation to Dryburgh Abbey in which his styled as son of the deceased Henry³ and gave homage to King Edward I. at St. Andrews on 22 July 1291, and again at Berwick-on-Tweed, in 1296. He was father of :

WILLIAM DE ANSTRUTHER, succeeded his father and confirmed and ratified the grants made by his father and grandfather to the monks of Dryburgh, which was confirmed by Bishop Lamberton in around 1330.⁴ He was father of :

HENRY DE ANSTRUTHER, succeeded his father and ratified the previous donations of his ancestors to the monks of Dryburgh.¹ He *m.* to a woman by the name of Matilda and was father of :

1. Richard de Anstruther, (*see below*).
2. Cecilia de Anstruther, *m.* by 2 January, 1352, to John Strang of Balcaskie.

RICHARD DE ANSTRUTHER, succeeded by 2 January, 1352, when a charter granted by him for a tenement within his land of Pitcorthy to John Strang and Cecilia de Anstruther, his sister, was confirmed by Sir Patrick de Dunbar, the superior.² He was father of :

ANDREW DE ANSTRUTHER, was a member of inquest at the retour of Margaret and Isabella Erskine, as heirs to their father Sir Alan de Erskine of Inchmartin, dated 26 May 1400. He was father of :

DAVID DE ANSTRUTHER OF THAT ILK, succeeded his father and is styled as deceased and grandfather to John Anstruther of that Ilk, on 2 July 1541. He was father of :

ANDREW ANSTRUTHER OF THAT ILK, succeeded his father and had Sasine for the lands of Anstruther in 1475.³ He was *k.* at the battle of Flodden on 9 September 1513, with the ward of his lands of Anstruther being granted by the King to Mr. Peter Sandilands, Parson of Calder, and Sir William Wardlaw, Parson of Tulliallan on August, 1515.⁴ He *m.* firstly, Christina Spens with whom he had a charter under the Great Seal of joint-infertment for the middle-part of the lands of Anstruther on 20 February, 1484,⁵ by whom he had no apparent issue. He *m.* secondly, Christian, daughter of Sir James Sandilands of Calder, (she was widow of David Hepburn of Waughton), and was father of :

1. John Anstruther of that Ilk, (*see below*).

He *m.* thirdly, Janet Borthwick, (who survived him and *m.* secondly, John Bethune of Balfour, to whom she was betrothed on 9 April, 1516), by whom he had no issue.

JOHN ANSTRUTHER OF THAT ILK, succeeded his father and had Sasine for the lands of Anstruther on 12 July 1514.¹ On 2 July 1541, he had a gift of the non-entry of his lands of Anstruther for all the years since the death of his grandfather David Anstruther of that Ilk,² and *m.* firstly, by 13 June, 1514, Margaret Douglas when they were infeft in the lands of Towquheis and Bralaw by Robert Douglas of Lochleven. He secondly, Elizabeth, daughter of Spens of Wormiston, and was father of :

ANDREW ANSTRUTHER OF THAT ILK, succeeded and *m.* by 5 October 1542, to Margaret, daughter of Thomas Abercromby of that Ilk.³ He was *k.* at the battle of Pinkiecleuch in September of 1547, and was father of :

1. John Anstruther of that Ilk, (*see below*).
2. John Anstruther, (secundus) was presented to the vicarage of Kilrennie on 17 February, 1579, which had fallen vacant by the demission of Mr. John Forman, and is then styled as father's brother to John Anstruther of that Ilk.⁴ He *m.* Jean, daughter of William Lindsay of Piotston, (she was widow of John Melville of Carnbee, who had *d.* in 1570).

JOHN ANSTRUTHER OF THAT ILK, who although underage, was retoured heir to his father in the lands of Anstruther on 2 October, 1548, by vitue of the declaration prior to the battle of Pinkiecleuch as to the succession of heirs. He *m.* firstly, Margaret, daughter of George Clephane of Carselogie, to whom he granted a charter for an annualrent to be uplifted from the lands of Mill of Anstruther in her virginity on 26 July, 1549,⁵ (she *d.* between 27 October 1571, and 14 November 1575), and secondly, Margaret, daughter of Patrick Learmonth of Dairsie, (she was widow of David Spens of Wormiston, by whom she had had issue), whom he infeft in a liferent of certain lands on 14 November, 1575.⁶ He was alive on 12 December 1593, *d.* by 17 May 1595, and was father of :

1. Sir James Anstruther of that Ilk, (*see below*).
2. Alison Anstruther, *m.* firstly, Alexander Nairne, indweller in St. Andrews, (*c/m* 21 December 1585¹), and secondly, Alexander Nicholson.
3. Grissell Anstruther, *m.* John Forret of Fingask.
4. Margaret Anstruther, *m.* by 29 May 1583, to Archibald Herring of Wester Gormock.

He was also father of a natural son :

5. Andrew Anstruther, with whom his father entered into a contract with Alexander Cunningham, fiar of Barns, on 5 June 1565.²

SIR JAMES ANSTRUTHER OF THAT ILK, was appointed one of the Royal Carvers for life on 29 May, 1575, and Master of the Queen's Household for life with a salary of £222 and 4 shillings on 17 May 1595,³ and with his father, had the lands of Anstruther erected into a Burgh of Barony by King James VI. in December of 1583. He *m.* Jean, daughter of Thomas Scott of Abbotshall, (*c/m* 27 October, 1571⁴), *d.* by August of 1611, and was father of :

1. **SIR WILLIAM ANSTRUTHER OF THAT ILK**, succeeded his father by 3 August 1611, when he granted a Charter to Patrick Black for the lands of Anstruther, under reversion,⁵ and *m.* Euphemia, daughter of Andrew Wemyss of Myrecairney. On 6 May 1647, he had a charter under the Great Seal confirming to him the lands and barony of Anstruther to be held by he and his heirs to be procreate, failing which, by Philip Anstruther, second son to his deceased brother Sir Robert Anstruther.⁶ He *dsp* between 8 November 1647, and 21 April 1649, and was succeeded by his nephew Sir Philip Anstruther.
2. Sir Robert Anstruther, witness to a charter by his brother Sir William Anstruther, fiar of that Ilk, to Robert Richardson, Burgess of Anstruther, for the lands of Mill of Anstruther, on 20 August

1608,¹ and *m.* Mary, daughter of Sir Edward Swift of Wheatley. He *d.* prior to May of 1647, and was father of,

2a) Robert Anstruther of Wheatley, succeeded to his mother's estate of Wheatley which was assigned to him upon his marriage, in 1673. He *m.* Jane, daughter of Sir John Corbet of Stoke, (*c/m* 9 August, 1673).

2a) **SIR PHILIP ANSTRUTHER OF THAT ILK**, (*see below*).

2a) Ursulla Anstruther, *m.* Austin of Guildford.

3. Margaret Anstruther, *m.* James Tweedie of Drumelzier.

4. Jean Anstruther, *m.* firstly, on 28 October, 1606, James Douglas, Commendator of Melrose, second son of William Douglas of Lochleven, (he was widow of Mary, daughter of Sir Thomas Ker of Ferniehurst, whom he had *m.* by *c/m* 6 November, 1587, and by whom he had issue ; and of Helen, daughter of William Scott of Abbotshall, with whom he was infert in the lands of Newlands on 19 October, 1596. He *d.* prior to 15 October, 1620), and secondly, by 28 January, 1630, to Sir John Riddell of that Ilk.²

5. Grisel Anstruther, *m.* Robert Alexander and had issue.

6. Agnes Anstruther, *m.* James Tweedie of Dryness.

SIR PHILIP ANSTRUTHER OF THAT ILK, to whom his uncle Sir William Anstruther of that Ilk made a resignation of the lands of Anstruther on 15 July, 1647, and for which he had a confirmation under the Great Seal on 21 April 1649³. He *m.* Christian, daughter of Sir James Lumsden of Innergellie, (*c/m* 15 July 1647⁴), *d.* in 1702 and was father of :

1. William Anstruther of that Ilk, (*see below*).

2. James Anstruther, 1st of Airdrie, to whom his father granted a tenement within the barony of Anstruther on 13 December, 1667, and is then styled as his second son.⁵ He *m.* Katherine, daughter of John Skene of Halyards, (she *m.* secondly, Major Andrew White and thirdly, Lord Edward Moray, fifth son of John Moray, 1st Marquis of Atholl, and *d.* in 1744), *d.* in 1682 and was father of :

2a) Sir Philip Anstruther, 2nd of Airdrie, *bap.* at Edinburgh on 26 July, 1682. He had a charter for the lands of Airdrie, as his father's heir, on 28 February, 1688, which he disposed to

his cousin John Anstruther, eldest and heir of Sir John Anstruther of that Ilk, on 8 September, 1747. He attained the rank of Lieutenant-General in the army and *d.* unmarried on 11 November, 1760.

2a) Christian Anstruther, *bap.* at Edinburgh on 30 December, 1680.

3. Sir Robert Anstruther of Balcaskie and 1st Baronet, had a grant of a tenement in Anstruther on 14 May, 1681, in which he is styled as third son¹ and was created a Baronet on 28 November, 1694. He *m.* firstly, Sophia, daughter of David Kinnear of that Ilk, and had no issue ; secondly, at Edinburgh, on 12 March, 1687, Jean, daughter of William Menteith of Wrae, and, thirdly, at Edinburgh, on 13 September, 1703, Marion, daughter of William Preston of Valleyfield. He *d.* in March of 1737² aged seventy-eight years, and was father of, :

3a) Sir Philip Anstruther of Balcaskie and 2nd Baronet, *b.* in 1688 and was served heir to his father on 2 February 1742. He *m.* Catherine, only daughter of Alexander Hay of Lawfield, (*c/m* 21 August & 4 September, 1738. She *d.* at Balcaskie on 11 February, 1759). He *d.* on 27 May, 1763, and was father of,

3b) Sir Robert Anstruther of Balcaskie and 3rd Baronet, *b.* on 19 April, 1733, and *m.* on 17 August, 1763, to Janet, daughter of Alexander Erskine, 5th Earl of Kellie. He *d.* at Balcaskie on 2 August, 1818,³ and was father of,

3c) Robert Anstruther, younger of Balcaskie, *b.* on 3 March, 1768, and attained the rank of Brigadier-General in the army. He *m.* on 16 March, 1799, to Lucy Charlotte, daughter of Lieutenant-Colonel James Hamilton, (she *d.* on 31 January, 1833), and *d. vita patris* on 14 January, 1809, being buried at Corunna, in Spain. He was father of,

3d) Sir Ralph Abercromby Anstruther of Balcaskie and 4th Baronet, *b.* on 1 March, 1804, and was served heir to his grandfather on 30 Jul 1851. He *m.* at Lambeth on Wednesday 7 September, 1831, to Mary Jane, eldest daughter of Major-General Sir Henry Torrens,⁴ *d.* at Balcaskie on Sunday 18 October, 1863,⁵ and was father of,

3e) Sir Robert Anstruther of Balcaskie and 5th Baronet, *b.* on 28 August, 1834, and succeeded his father. He *m.* on 29 July, 1857,

to Louisa Maria, daughter of Rev. William Knox Marshall, and *d.* at Balcaskie House on 21 July, 1886.¹ He was father of,

3f) Sir Ralph William Anstruther of Balcaskie and 6th Baronet, *b.* on 5 July, 1858, and succeeded his father. He *m.* on 5 August, 1885, to Mildred Harriet, daughter of Edward Hussey, and *d.* on 30 September, 1934. He was father of,

3g) Robert Edward Anstruther, *b.* on 4 April, 1890, *m.* on 16 June, 1919, to Marguerite, daughter of Hugo de Burgh. He *d.* on 22 July, 1921, of wounds he had received during WWI. and was father of,

3h) **SIR RALPH HUGO ANSTRUTHER OF THAT ILK, 6TH BARONET OF BALCASKIE AND 12TH BARONET OF ANSTRUTHER**, *b.* on 13 June, 1921, and succeeded to the representation of the Anstruther family in 1980. He *d.* unmarried on 19 May, 2002.

3g) Margaret Christian Anstruther, *b.* on 16 August, 1887, and *d.* on 8 September, 1925.

3g) Magdalen Janet Anstruther, *b.* on 19 April, 1889, and *m.* on 14 August, 1911, to Lieutenant-Colonel Sir Thomas Erskine. She *d.* on 15 February, 1953, and had issue.

3g) Sarah Katherine Anstruther, *b.* on 28 September, 1894, and *d.* unmarried on 22 December, 1952.

3g) Elizabeth Mildred Louisa Anstruther, *b.* on 29 April, 1896, and *m.* on 20 October, 1920, to Major Julian Neil Oscar Rycroft. She *d.* on 11 September, 1932, and had issue.

3g) Gertrude Mary Anstruther, *b.* on 9 March, 1900, and *d.* unmarried on 10 April, 1975.

3f) Henry Torrens Anstruther, *b.* on 27 November, 1860, and studying law, he was called to the Scottish Bar in 1885, however, following politics, he was returned MP for St. Andrews Discript and Burghs which he ehld until his

3g) Douglas Tollemache Anstruther, *b.* on 15 July, 1893, and *m.* first, on 9 December, 1914, to Enid, daughter of George Grenville Campbell, (marriage dissolved by divorce in 1925). He *m.* second, on 15 October, 1925, to Evelyn Mabel, daughter of Sir John Wormald, *d.* on 23 July, 1956, and was father of,

3h) Adrian Fagus Campbell Anstruther, *b.* on 28 April, 1917, and *dsp* on 2 January, 1932.

3h) **SIR IAN FIFE CAMPBELL ANSTRUTHER OF THAT ILK AND 13TH BARONET**, *b.* on 11 May, 1922, and succeeded his cousin in the family representation and honours. He *m.* first, on 7 March, 1951, to Geraldine Honor, daughter of Captain Gerald Stuart Blake, (marriage dissolved by divorce in 1963). He *m.* second, on 15 November, 1963, to Susan Margaret, daughter of Henry St. John Brading Paten, and *d.* on 29 July, 2007. He was father of,

3i) Emily Kate Campbell Anstruther, *b.* on 25 January, 1953.

3i) **SEBASTIAN PATEN ANSTRUTHER OF THAT ILK AND 14TH BARONET**, *b.* on 13 September, 1962, and *m.* in 1992, to Porpan Pinitwong. He is father of,
