

BAIN

OF FINDALL

ANDREW BAIN, 1ST OF FINDALL, of unknown parentage, acquired the lands of Findall and Dargill from James Sinclair of Banks by Disposition dated 5 November, 1611, and in which he was infeft on 4 February, 1614.¹ He *m.* Elizabeth, daughter of William Graham of Calendar, *d.* in January of 1620² and was father of :

1. James Bain, 2nd of Findall, (*see below*).
2. John Bain, who, with his brother James, acted as cautioner to their sister Agnes in her marriage contract with Patrick Robertson in 1634.
3. Elizabeth Bain, *m.* John Drummond, 2nd of Kildees,³ and had issue.
4. Anna Bain, *m.* James Drummond, younger son of Patrick Drummond, 4th of Milnab,⁴ and had issue.
5. Marjory Bain,
6. Jean Bain,
7. Agnes Bain, all of whom are named in their father's Testament in 1620. She *m.* Patrick Robertson, eldest son and heir of Patrick Robertson, Chirurgeon and Burgess of Perth, (*c/m* at Perth on 15 January 1634⁵).

JAMES BAIN, 2ND OF FINDALL, succeeded his father and had a Precept of Clare Constat for his infeftment as heir to his deceased father in the lands of Findall and Dargill on 26 July, 1630.⁶ He was an active Royalist during the civil war and as a result of which he and his family became so reduced in circumstances that they had to "beg for their

bread.”¹ He *m.* Katherine, daughter of Robert Graham of Cairnie, (*c/m* 10 August, 1630²), *d.* in December of 1652³ and was father of :

1. James Bain, 3rd of Findall, (*see below*).
2. Robert Bain, was admitted Minister of Newburgh on 11 April, 1672, and was appointed Tutor to his nephew Patrick Bain of Findall, on 28 December, 1680.⁴ He *m.* Elizabeth Cunningham, (she survived him and *m.* secondly on 6 February, 1687, to John Fairfoull⁵), *d.* in June of 1684⁶ and was father of :
 - 2a) John Bain, *bap.* at Newburgh on 17 May, 1674.
 - 2a) Robert Bain, *bap.* at Newburgh on 23 March, 1681.
 - 2a) Alexander Bain, *bap.* at Newburgh on 12 August, 1684.
 - 2a) James Bain,
 - 2a) Marion Bain, *bap.* at Newburgh on 25 November, 1678.
3. Janet Bain, *m.* Alexander MacGregor of Balnacuil, and had issue.
4. Agnes Bain, *m.* John MacGregor, 3rd of Culcrieff, by whom she was infert in the lands of Culcrieff in implementation of their contract of marriage on 15 November, 1653, and had no issue ; and secondly at Dunblane on 7 April, 1656, George Graham, *fiar* of Glenly, ⁷ and had issue.
5. Annabell Bain, all of whom are named in their father’s Testament,

JAMES BAIN, 3RD OF FINDALL, had a Precept of Clare Constat for his infertment as heir to his deceased father in the lands of Findall and Dargell on 7 August, 1663, and for which lands he took Sasine on 6 April, 1665.⁸ He *d.* in October of 1680⁹ having *m.* firstly, to Elizabeth, sister of Gavin Drummond, 1st of Belliclone, whom he infert in the liferent

of the lands of Findall in implementation of a contract of marriage on 10 August, 1667,¹ (she *d.* in July of 1668²), and by her he had issue :

1. Katherine Bain, named in her mother's Testament in 1668.

He *m.* secondly, Giles, daughter of Patrick Murray, portioner of Ardbenny, (*c/m* 19 April, 1670³), by whom he was father of :

2. Patrick Bain, 4th of Findall, (*see below*).

3. Margaret Bain, *m.* Thomas Greg, only son of Gilbert Greg of Haugh of Fungorth, (*c/m* 19 March, 1708⁴), and had issue.

PATRICK BAIN, 4TH OF FINDALL, who was underage at the time of his father's death and was placed under the care of his paternal uncle Robert Bain, Minister of Newburgh, on 28 December, 1680.⁵ He had a Precept of Clare Constat for infetment as heir to his deceased father in the lands of Findall and Dargell on 10 October, 1683,⁶ which he afterwards disposed to James Drummond, Earl of Perth, by Disposition dated 5 May, 1698.⁷ He *m.* at Madderty on 5 October, 1707, Jean, daughter of Mungo Murray, 1st of Lintrose,⁸ *d.* prior to August of 1737 when his only child, his daughter Jean Bain, was served his heir general, and was father of :

JEAN BAIN, *m.* Mr. John Gall of Kinloch, (*c/m* 6 February, 1730.⁹ He survived her and *m.* secondly, on 22 April 1744, Mary, daughter of George Graham, 3rd of Pitcairns¹⁰), and was retoured heir-general to her father on 10 August 1737.
