

BARRON

OF KINNAIRD

JAMES BARRON, was admitted a Burgess of Edinburgh on 28 March, 1508,¹ and was father of :

ANDREW BARRON, admitted a Burgess of Edinburgh by right of his father on 14 March, 1517,² and was father of :

1. Patrick Barron, admitted a Burgess of Edinburgh by right of his father on 5 January, 1547.³
2. James Barron of Kinnaird, (*see below*).

JAMES BARRON, 1ST OF KINNAIRD, was a successful Merchant in Edinburgh and was admitted a Burgess of that city by right of his father on 5 January, 1547.⁴ He *m.* Helen, sister and heiress of Thomas Leslie of Kinnaird,⁵ (she *m.* secondly, by 29 September, 1571, to James Kirkcaldy, brother of Sir William Kirkcaldy of Grange. He was executed in 1572, and by whom she had issue), with whom on her resignation they had a charter for the middle-part of the lands of Glassmont and Kinnaird on 23 October, 1561.⁶ He *d.* prior to September of 1571 and was father of :

GEORGE BARRON, 2ND OF KINNAIRD, succeeded to the lands of Kinnaird and was retoured heir to Robert Leslie of Innerpeffer, his great-grandfather, on 20 February, 1606.⁷ He *m.* firstly, by 18 May, 1587, Elizabeth, daughter of George Learmonth of

Balcomie, when on his resignation, they had a charter of joint-infeftment for the lands of Kinnaird. Surviving her, he *m.* secondly, by 8 June, 1598, Euphemia Collace, when they had a charter of joint-infeftment for the lands of Kinnaird, and had the lands of Hilton Malar and Kinnaird appraised by Mr Thomas Rollock in 1606. He was father of :

JOHN BARRON, had a charter for the lands of Hilton Malar from Sir James Forrester of Corstorphine on 28 March, 1616, in which he is styled as eldest son of George Barron, sometime of Kinnaird.

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
