

BOSWELL

OF GLASSMONTH

1. John Boswell of Pittedie, *dsp* prior to March of 1637, and was succeeded by his brother James.
2. James Boswell of Glassmonth, (*see below*).

JAMES BOSWELL OF GLASSMONTH, acquired part of the lands of Glassmonth and succeeded his brother John Boswell of Pittedie, to whom he was served heir in the lands of Pittedie on 25 March 1637. He *d.* by 27 December following and was father of :

1. David Boswell of Glassmonth, (*see below*).
2. Patrick Boswell, settled at Pittedie and had the wadset of the lands of Wester Balgilly on 3 September 1642.¹ He *m.* by that date to Janet, daughter of John Boswell, skipper burghess of Burntisland,² (she survived him and *m.* secondly by 1666, to George Halket, burghess of Kinghorn, by whom she had further issue), and *d.* after 13 June 1644, and by October of 1647. He was father of :

2a) John Boswell, who was under age at his father's death and to whom his uncle David Boswell of Glassmonth was appointed Tutor on 27 October 1647. He was infeft in the lands of Wester Balgilly by the superior, David Boswell, fiar of Balmutto, in 1655.³

2a) Janet Boswell, *bap.* at Kinghorn on 22 December 1641.

2a) Margaret Boswell, *bap.* at Kinghorn on 8 December 1646.

DAVID BOSWELL OF GLASSMONTH, succeeded his father and was served heir to his uncle, John Boswell of Pittedie, to whom he was served heir in those lands of 27 December 1637, and which he afterwards disposed to Sir John Scott of Scotstarvit. He appears to have been father of :

JOHN BOSWELL OF GLASSMONTH, succeeded and *m.* Janet Jameson by whom he was father of :

DAVID BOSWELL OF NETHER GLASSMONTH, is named with his parents¹ and *m.* Christian, daughter of Andrew Boswell of Balberton. He was father of :

1. John Boswell, *bap.* at Kinghorn on 6 October 1684, and *dsp.*
2. **ANDREW BOSWELL OF GLASSMONTH**, *bap.* at Kinghorn on 6 December 1685, and succeeded his father. He *dsp* by 7 July 1736, when his brother, David, was served his heir.
3. **DAVID BOSWELL OF GLASSMONTH**, *bap.* at Kinghorn on 24 November 1686, and succeeded his brother Andrew, to whom he was served heir on 7 July 1736. He *dsp* by 31 January 1769, when his niece and nephew, John and Janet Foote, were served his heir.
4. Walter Boswell, *b.* on 29 April 1691, and was apprenticed to Robert Reid, Saddler burghess of Edinburgh, on 30 May 1705.² He was admitted to Burgess of Edinburgh on 5 August 1713,³ and *m.* at Edinburgh on 4 September 1713, to Janet, daughter of William Baillie, Wright Burgess of Edinburgh.⁴ He *dsp*, his great-niece, Elizabeth Boswell or Foote being served his heir on 7 April 1762.
5. Elizabeth Boswell, *bap.* at Kinghorn on 30 June 1693, and *m.* Andrew Futt of Glenscherop, by whom she had issue :
 - 5a) John Foote or Boswell, was apprenticed to his uncle Walter Boswell, Saddler in Edinburgh, on 22 April 1730,⁵ and was admitted to burghess there on 20 July 1743.⁶ He was father of :
 - 5b) Elizabeth Foote or Boswell, was served heir to her grand uncle, Walter Boswell, Saddler Burgess of Edinburgh, on 7 April 1762.
 - 5a) Janet Futt, was served heir portioner to her uncle David Boswell of Glassmonth on 31 January 1769.
6. Jean Boswell, *bap.* at Kinghorn on 22 October 1695.
