

BRUCE

OF KINLOCH

ANDREW BRUCE OF KINLOCH, *d.* prior to January of 1684 and was father of :

1. James Bruce of Kinloch, (*see below*).
2. William Bruce, apprenticed to Patrick Cunningham, Apothecary in Edinburgh, on 6 February 1684.¹

JAMES BRUCE OF KINLOCH, was served heir to his father in the lands of Kinloch, with the mill, brewlands and smiddielands on 3 January 1684,² and *m.* Isabel, daughter of John Oliphant, 2nd of Carpow, (*c/m* 6 April 1703³). He *d.* in November of 1727 and was father of :

1. **ANDREW BRUCE OF KINLOCH**, succeeded his father and was served his heir in the lands of Kinloch, in the parish of Collessie, on 29 September 1763. He *d.* in February 1766, and was succeeded by his brother, David.
2. **DAVID BRUCE OF KINLOCH**, succeeded his brother Andrew in the lands of Kinloch and was served his heir on 1 May 1766. He *d.* without apparent issue at Kinloch on 19 May 1781, with his lands afterwards being sold.
3. Anna Bruce, *m.* Alexander Clephane, second son of George Clephane of Carselogie.
4. Helen Bruce, *m.* on 27 November 1746, to Mr. Thomas Stark of Ballindean, and *d.* on 18 October 1800. They had issue.
