

CAMPBELL

OF LUNDIE

COLIN CAMPBELL OF LUNDIE, to whom the lands and barony of Lundy, Polkello, Polcalk, mill of Tealing and others, were assigned by his father Colin, Earl of Argyll by charter dated 24 May 1583, and in which he is styled as the second son.¹ He *m.* Maria, daughter of Sir Colin Campbell, 6th of Glenorchy, (*c/m* at Finlarig on 26 June, 1599.² She was widow of William Graham, 5th Earl of Menteith, by whom she had issue), *d.* after 24 October 1617, and prior to 31 March 1619, and was father of :

1. Sir Colin Campbell, 1st Baronet of Lundie, (*see below*).
2. John Campbell of Friarton, obtained the lands of Frairton and granted a Bond for 200 merks Scots to Agnes, daughter of David Grant of Lympotts, on 22 March, 1673, in which he is styled as brother to Colin Campbell of Lundie. He *m.* Christine, daughter of Martin Corstorphine of Cassindonald.³
3. Catherine Campbell, had an annualrent to be uplifted from the lands of Lundie on 24 October, 1617. She *m.* by 1622, to Gilbert Monorgund, younger of that Ilk, and is styled as daughter of the deceased Colin Campbell of Lundie on 11 July 1629, when she raised an action against her brother, Colin Campbell of Lundie, for payment of certain sums of money due to her.⁴

SIR COLIN CAMPBELL, 1ST BARONET OF LUNDIE, to whom his father conveyed the barony of Lundie on 24 October 1617,⁵ and to whom he was retoured heir on 15 May, 1624.⁶ He was created a Baronet of Nova Scotia in 1627 with remainder to himself and the heirs of his body, which failing, to his heirs male whatsoever and *m.* Jean Stirling

with whom he dispined his lands of Polkello, and others, to Sir William Graham of Claverhouse, on 7 May 1630.¹ He *d.* by April of 1673, and was father of :

1. Sir Colin Campbell, 2nd Baronet, (*see below*).
2. John Campbell, apprenticed to John Threipland, Goldsmith in Edinburgh, on 3 December, 1679.²

SIR COLIN CAMPBELL, 2ND BARONET OF LUNDIE, succeeded his father and was retoured his heir in the Barony of Lundie on 23 April, 1674,³ which he afterwards dispined to Alexander Duncan of Seaside, on 15 June 1676. He *m.* Helen Abercrombie and by her he was father of :

1. John Campbell, *b.* in 1676.
