

DOW OF TIRCHARDY

JAMES DOW OF TIRCHARDY, *m.* Catherine, sister of Mungo Campbell of Kinloch, (*c/m* 1 November 1678. She survived him and *m.* secondly, to James MacNab in Kinnell), and was father of,

JOHN DOW OF TIRCHARDY, succeeded his father and *m.* Margaret, daughter of Donald MacIntyre in Kenmore, (*c/m* 4 January 1697¹). He was father of :

GEORGE DOW OF TIRCHARDY, was father of,

1. James Dow of Tirchardy, (*see below*).
2. Elizabeth Dow, *m.* on 29 March 1751, John Campbell of Garrows.

JAMES DOW OF TIRCHARDY, was father of,

1. John Dow of Tirchardy, (*see below*).
2. Margaret Dow, *m.* at Dull on 25 January 1803, John Campbell of Garrows.
3. Janet Dow, a natural daughter. She was *c.* at Dull on 14 July 1754.

JOHN DOW OF TIRCHARDY, succeeded his father in the lands of Tirchardy and was served heir to his great-grand uncle Charles Dunstar, Innkeeper in St-Martins-in-the-Fields, on 30 January 1772. He *m.* _____ (she *d.* at Tirchardy on 19 September 1847, aged 88 years), and was father of :

GEORGE DOW OF TIRCHARDY, *b.* in 1789, and *d.* at Amulree on 2 March 1866. He *m.* Margaret Dewar, and was father of,

1. Peter Dewar Dow of Tirchardy, (*see below*).

PETER DEWAR DOW OF TIRCHARDY, *c.* at Dull on 31 October 1828, succeeded his father in the lands of Tirchardy on his death in 1866, which he afterwards sold. He *m.* at Edinburgh on 2 August 1853, to Margaret, daughter of Daniel MacGregor, and was father of,

1. George Patrick Dow, *b.* at Edinburgh on 15 August 1854, and *d.* at Eglinton Street, Glasgow, on 21 May 1883.
2. Daniel Campbell Dow, *d.* at Earl Grey Street, Edinburgh, on 24 September 1874, aged 17 years.
3. John A. Down, *b.* at Edinburgh on 1861.
4. Isabella Mary Dow, *b.* at Edinburgh on 22 October 1858, and *m.* at Fairholm, Pollockshields, on 5 August 1897, to John MacGregor, Coalmaster.
