

ELPHINSTONE

OF LOGIE

WILLIAM ELPHINSTONE, *m.* Margaret Forbes and was father of :

SIR JAMES ELPHINSTONE, 1ST BARONET OF LOGIE, was apprenticed to Archibald Nisbet W.S., was admitted a Writer to the Signet on 16 August 1671, and was created a Baronet on 2 December 1701. He *m.* at Edinburgh on 2 September 1673, to Cecilia, daughter of John Denholm, Merchant in Edinburgh,¹ in whose right he was admitted Burgess of Edinburgh on 3 January 1677,² *d.* on 10 March 1722,³ aged 78 years, and was father of :

1. Sir John Elphinstone, 2nd Baronet of Logie, (*see below*).
2. Robert Elphinstone, *c.* at Edinburgh on 12 September 1678.
3. James Elphinstone, *c.* at Edinburgh on 9 September 1682.
4. Alexander Elphinstone, *c.* at Edinburgh on 5 June 1685.
5. Margaret Elphinstone, *m.* at Edinburgh on 6 July 1692, to Mr. Robert Forbes, Advocate, third son of Sir John Forbes of Craigievar,⁴ (*c/m* 1692⁵), and had issue.
7. Catherine Elphinstone, *c.* at Edinburgh on 21 June 1674.

SIR JOHN ELPHINSTONE, 2ND BARONET OF LOGIE, *c.* at Edinburgh on 8 August 1675, succeeded his father and was served his heir on 19 February 1726. He *m.* at Edinburgh on 23 August 1703, to Mary, only daughter of Sir Gilbert Elliot, Baronet of Headschaws,⁶ (*c/m* 21 August 1703⁷), *d.* in March of 1732⁸ and was father of :

1. **SIR JAMES ELPHINSTONE, 3RD BARONET OF LOGIE**, succeeded his father and was served his heir in the lands of Craighouse, Logie and Quarrell on 31 October 1733. He *m.* at Edinburgh on 30 September 1733, to Jean, daughter of Thomas Rattray of Craighall,¹ (she survived him and *m.* secondly, to Colonel George Muir), *d.* prior to June of 1740 and was father of :

1a) **MARY ELPHINSTONE OF LOGIE**, *b.* at Edinburgh on 27 April 1737. She and her sister, Margaret, were served heirs of line to their father on 21 June 1740. She was served heir to her uncle, Sir John Elphinstone of Logie, in the lands of Logie-Elphinstone on 12 April 1743, and *m.* on 9 July 1754, to Robert Dalrymple Horn of Horn² by whom she had issue which succeeded her in the lands of Logie Elphinstone.

1a) Margaret Elphinstone, was a co-heir of her father in 1740 and had apparently *d.* by April of 1743 when her sister Mary was sole heir to their uncle Sir John Elphinstone of Logie.

2. Gilbert Elphinstone, *b.* on 9 February 1713, and *d.* young.

3. **SIR JOHN ELPHINSTONE, 4TH BARONET OF LOGIE**, *b.* at Edinburgh on 11 January 1717, succeeded his brother Sir James to whom he was retoured heir male on 21 June 1740. He *d.* in January of 1743, with his niece Mary Elphinstone being served his heir in the lands of Logie-Elphinstone on 12 April 1743.

4. Hugh Elphinstone, *b.* on 1 March 1720.

5. Cecilia Elphinstone, *b.* on 30 June 1704, and *m.* on 29 August 1739, to James Balfour of Pilrig,³ (*c/m* 27 August 1737⁴).

6. Mary Elphinstone, *b.* at Edinburgh on 1 March 1712, and *m.* in 1757, to Sir Andrew Mitchell of Westshore, Baronet.

7. Jean Elphinstone, *b.* on 23 February 1714, and *dsp* prior to 27 May 1760, when her sisters Cecilia, Elizabeth, Helen, Mary, Margaret and Marion were served her heirs.

8. Margaret Elphinstone, *b.* on 5 September 1715.

9. Helen Elphinstone, *b.* on 16 July 1723, and *m.* at Edinburgh on 21 April 1751, to Dr. Thomas Elliot, Edinburgh.⁵

10. Elizabeth Elphinstone, *b.* on 26 July 1725, *m.* on 29 April 1745, to Henry Crawford of Monorgan, (he *m.* secondly, at Dundee, on 21 October 1768, to Helen Murray *d.* at Dundee on 17 January 1789¹), and *d.* on at Monorgund on 11 October 1762.²
