

# GIB

## OF LOCHTON

**ANDREW GIB OF LOCHTON**, acquired the lands of Lochton for which he had a charter under the Great Seal dated 16 December 1681. He was father of :

**ROBERT GIB OF LOCHTON**, *m.* Margaret, daughter of David Drummond of Hollhill,<sup>1</sup> (she was widow of Robert Chalmer of Mill of Banchrie, whom she had *m.* by contract 13 September 1680) and was father of :

**ANDREW GIB OF LOCHTON**, *m.* Jean, daughter of Henry Blair of Cronan, (*c/m* 13 March 1711<sup>2</sup>), and was father of,

1. Robert Gib, younger of Lochton, to whom his sister Margaret was served heir on 18 June 1746.
2. William Gib of Lochton, (*see below*).
3. Margaret Gib, *c.* at Longforgan on 9 May 1718, *m.* John Frier, Merchant in Lethendy, and was served heir of provision to her brother Robert, firstly, on 18 June 1746, and again on 16 April 1760.

**WILLIAM GIB OF LOCHTON**, was served heir to his father on 2 March 1757, and had a charter under the Great Seal for lands of Lochton on 24 February 1772.
