

HALL

OF DUNGLASS

SIR JOHN HALL, 1ST OF DUNGLASS, was a successful merchant, bailie and Provost of Edinburgh and acquired the lands of Dunglass. He was created a Baronet on 8 October 1687 with remainder to the heirs male of his own body and *d.* in October of 1695, being buried in the Greyfriars, Edinburgh, on 18th of that month,¹. He *m.* at Edinburgh on 17 December 1668, to Catherine, eldest daughter of James Loch of Drylaw,² (*c/m* 17 December 1663.³ She was widow of Dr. John Meine, *fiar* of Craigmuck, whom she had *m.* by *c/m* 14 February 1662,⁴ and was buried in the Greyfriars, Edinburgh, on 13 November 1690⁵), and was father of :

1. Sir James Hall, 2nd of Dunglass, (*see below*).
2. William Hall of Whitehill, *bap.* at Edinburgh on 15 January 1675, was appointed Principal Clerk of Session and *dsp* at Whitehall on Sunday 16 October 1748,⁶ his nephew, Sir John Hall of Dunglass, being served his heir on 12 January 1750.
3. Isabel Hall, *bap.* at Edinburgh on 14 October 1669, *m.* James Pringle of Torwoodlee, (*c/m* 20 October 1691⁷), and had issue.
4. Katherine Hall, *bap.* at Edinburgh on 22 September 1677, *m.* on 23 April 1707, to Sir James Haliburton of Pitcur, (*c/m* 28 April, 1707.⁸ He was widow of Elizabeth, daughter of Adam Gardyne of Greenhall, by whom he had no issue ; and survived Katherine Hall, he *m.* thirdly, on 25 August 1709, to Mary, daughter of George Drummond of Blair Drummond, by whom he had issue), and *dsp.*

SIR JAMES HALL, 2ND OF DUNGLASS, *bap.* at Edinburgh on 12 December 1673, succeeded his father on his death and was served his heir in £5,630 secured over the lands of Scotsraig and Southferry of Portincraig, in Fife, on 31 January 1723. He *m.* firstly, to Anna, daughter of Patrick Home, Lord Polwarth, (*c/m* 8 April 1697.¹ She *d.* in January of 1699), by whom he had no apparent issue ; and secondly, on 9 December of 1705, to Margaret, daughter of Sir John Pringle, 2nd Baronet of Stichill, (*c/m* 25 December 1705²), and *d.* at Edinburgh on Friday 26 March 1742.³ He was father of :

1. Sir John Hall, 3rd of Dunglass, (*see below*).
2. William Hall of Whitehill, who *d.* without apparent issue on 3 April 1800, his nephew Sir James Hall being served his heir in the lands and barony of Chirnside with the manor place of Whitehill, on 11 December 1800.
3. James Hall, *b.* at Edinburgh on 10 January 1724.
4. Robert Hall, was serving as a Lieutenant-Colonel in the army on 27 July 1745.
5. Alexander Hall, who granted a factory to his brothers Sir John Hall and William on 25 November 1762.⁴ He entered the H.E.I.C.S., was one of the Council at Bencoolen, and *d.* at Sumatra on 17 December 1764.⁵
6. Margaret Hall, *bap.* on 10 January 1714.
7. Katherine Hall, *bap.* on 26 May 1716, and *m.* at Edinburgh on 6 March 1743, to William Hamilton, brother and eventual heir to John Hamilton of Bangour,⁶ (he *d.* on 25 March 1754). They had issue.
8. Magdalen Hall, *d.* at Edinburgh on Saturday 28 December 1754.⁷
9. Isabel Hall, granted a discharge to her brother Sir John Hall for payment of a provision, dated 15 April 1755.⁸

SIR JOHN HALL, 3RD BARONET OF DUNGLASS, *bap.* on 5 October 1711, succeeded his father and was served his heir general on 8 July 1743. He *m.* at Stichill on 16 October

1759, to Magdalen, eldest daughter of Sir Robert Pringle of Stichill,¹ *d.* at Dunglass on Wednesday 3 July 1776,² and was father of :

1. Sir James Hall, 4th Baronet of Dunglass, (*see below*).
2. Robert Hall, *b.* on 19 August 1762.

SIR JAMES HALL, 4TH BARONET OF DUNGLASS, *b.* on 17 January 1761, succeeded his father and was served his heir general on 7 July 1780. He *m.* on 9 November 1786, to Helen, daughter of Dunbar Douglas, 4th Earl of Selkirk, *d.* at Edinburgh on 23 June 1832, in his 72nd year³ and was father of :

1. Sir John Hall, 5th of Dunglass, (*see below*).
2. Basil Hall, *b.* on 31 December 1788, entered the Royal Navy and was raised to Captain. He *m.* at St. Jon's Chapel, Edinburgh, on 1 March 1825, to Margaret, youngest daughter of Sir John Hunter, British Consul-General in Spain,⁴ *d.* at Hasler Hospital on Wednesday 11 September 1844,⁵ and was father of :

2a) Basil Sidmouth de Ros Hall, *b.* on 8 August 1833, and entered the Royal Navy, being raised to Captain. He *m.* at Trinity Church, Gloucester Gardens, London, on 4 May 1864, to Grace, youngest daughter of Major-General Sir William Reid,⁶ *d.* at Mayence, on the Rhine, on 11 July 1871,⁷ and was father of :

2b) Basil William Reid Hall, *b.* on 31 October 1865, entered the Royal Navy and was raised to Commander. He *m.* on 8 May 1894, to Cecil Mary, daughter of John Woodgate Ashburnham, *dsp* on 10 August 1942.

2b) Lionel Erskine Hall, *b.* on 18 July 1868, and served as Captain in the 4th Battalion South Staffordshire Regiment. He *m.* at St. Mary Abbot's Church, Kensington,

London, on 21 April 1897, to Jane Augusta, daughter of Thomas Leetham Reynolds,¹ *d.* on 8 March 1948, and was father of :

2c) **SIR LIONEL REID HALL, 12TH BARONET OF DUNGLASS**, *b.* at Riverside, Woking, on 1 February 1898, and succeeded to the Dunglass Baronety as heir male. He *m.* on 29 March 1921, to Mary Marjoribanks, daughter of Major-General Sir Gerard Moore Heath, *d.* on 22 April 1975, and was father of :

2d) Mary Jane Rosamund Hall, *b.* on 6 January 1922, and *m.* on 1 May 1946, to Mark Peter Whitlock. They have issue.

2d) Elizabeth Catharine Marion Hall, *b.* on 16 October 1925, and *m.* on 29 March 1949, to Dr. Oliphant Fairburn Jackson. She *d.* on 23 February 2011, leaving issue.

2d) Teresa Madeleine Hall, *b.* on 19 June 1930, and *m.* on 3 January 1952, to Herbert Norman Constantine. She *d.* on 2 January 2015, having had issue.

2c) **SIR NEVILLE REYNOLDS HALL, 13TH BARONET OF DUNGLASS**, *b.* at Riverside, Woking, on 16 February 1900, and succeeded his brother on his death in 1973. He *m.* on 22 June 1957, to Dorothy Maud, daughter of William Lawrence Jones, and *dsp* on 5 July 1978, being succeeded by his brother, Douglas.

2c) **SIR DOUGLAS BASIL HALL, 14TH BARONET OF DUNGLASS**, *b.* on 1 February 1909, and succeeded his brother Neville on his death in 1978. He *m.* on 25 April 1933, to Rachel Marion, daughter of Major Ernest Gartside-Tipping, *d.* on 8 April 2004, and was father of :

2d) Basil James Hall, *b.* on 28 June 1935, and *d.* on 12 September following.

2d) **SIR JOHN DOUGLAS HOSTE HALL, 15TH BARONET OF DUNGLASS**, *b.* on 7 January 1945, and succeeded his father on his death in 2004. He *m.* on 30 December 1972, to Angela Margaret, daughter of George Keys, and has issue :

2e) Thomas James Hall, *b.* on 10 December 1975.

2e) Bernard Neville Hall, *b.* on 19 February 1979.

2d) Marion Hall, *b.* on 18 July 1940, and *m.* on 10 July 1965, to John Francis Fuller-Sessions. They have issue.

- 2d) Ruth Hall, *b.* on 4 March 1942, and *m.* on 6 July 1963, to Anthony Bernard Cragg. They had issue.
- 2b) Helen Sara Margaret Hall, *d.* on 25 December 1882.
- 2a) Elizabeth Jane Hall, *b.* on 24 February 1826, *m.* on 19 June 1845, to Rear-Admiral William Chamberlain, and *d.* on 29 August 1859.
- 2a) Frances Emily Hall, *m.* on 5 May 1855, to Alfred Christian, and *d.* on 3 April 1905, having had issue.
3. William Hall, *b.* on 3 June 1790.
 4. Alexander Hall, *b.* on 10 December 1797.
 5. James Hall, *b.* on 6 June 1800, and became a painter of some repute. He *d.* unmarried at Ashiesteel on 26 October 1854.
 6. Magdalen Hall, *b.* on 22 March 1793, *m.* firstly, at Edinburgh on 21 March 1815, to Sir William Howe de Lancey, (he was *k.* at the battle of Waterloo), and secondly, at Dunglass House on 27 March 1819, to Henry Harvey, Madras Army.
 7. Elizabeth Hall, *b.* on 12 August 1796, and *m.* at Edinburgh in February of 1824, to Rev. George Pollen Boilean Pollen, Rector of Little Bookham, Surrey.¹ She *d.* on 26 February 1873.
 8. Katherine Mary Hall, *b.* on 5 April 1799, and *m.* at Edinburgh on 18 December 1835, to Colonel Sir James Russell of Ashiesteel,² (he *d.* at Ashiesteel on 16 May 1859³). She *d.* on 14 May 1872.
 9. Frances Hall, *b.* on 21 July 1801.
 10. Helen Hall, *b.* on 10 November 1809.

SIR JOHN HALL, 5TH OF DUNGLASS, *b.* on 16 September 1787, succeeded his father on his death in 1832, and *m.* at Edinburgh on 23 January 1823, to Juliana, youngest daughter of James Walker of Dalry. He *d.* at Lowdnes Square, London, on Monday 2 April 1860,⁴ and was father of :

1. **SIR JAMES HALL, 6TH OF DUNGLASS**, *b.* at Edinburgh on 17 February 1824, and succeeded his father on his death in 1860. He *d.* unmarried on Sunday 7 May 1876,⁵ being succeeded by his brother, Douglas.

2. **SIR BASIL FRANCIS HALL, 7TH OF DUNGLASS**, *b.* on 1 June 1828, and succeeded his brother Sir James, on his death in 1876. He *m.* on 10 March 1887, to Adelaide Catherine, third daughter of Robert Kerr Elliot of Harwood, (she *d.* at St. Aidans, North Berwick, on 2 February 1926¹), and *dsp* at Dunglass House on Wednesday 13 January 1909,² being succeeded by his brother, Henry.
3. Charles Thomas Hall, *b.* at Dunglass House on 28 July 1830.
4. **SIR HENRY JOHN HALL, 8TH BARONET OF DUNGLASS**, *b.* on 26 September 1835, succeeded his brother Sir Douglas, and *d.* unmarried at Brighton on 25 March 1913.
5. Julian Hamilton Hall, *b.* on 17 January 1837, entered the army and served as Lieutenant-General, Coldstream Guards. He *m.* on 6 July 1864, to Augusta Wilhelmina Louisa, daughter of Major-General John Fremantle, *d.* on 15 August 1911,³ and was father of :
 - 5a) **SIR JOHN RICHARD HALL, 9TH BARONET OF DUNGLASS**, succeeded his uncle, Sir Henry Hall, in 1913 and being burdened with heavy death duties, he was compelled to sell Dunglass in 1920. He *m.* on 1 January 1903, to Sophy Mary, daughter of Henry Duncan of Ruthwell, (she *d.* in 1952), and *dsp* on 15 February 1928.
 - 5a) Ralph Henry Seymour Hall, *b.* on 12 June 1868, and *m.* on 25 September 1902, to Annie Charlotte, daughter of General Edward Stopford Claremont. He *dsp* on 29 January 1903.
 - 5a) **SIR MARTIN JULIAN HALL, 10TH BARONET OF DUNGLASS**, *b.* on 23 March 1874, and succeeded his brother on his death in 1903. He *m.* on 9 December 1905, to Alice Mary, daughter of William Wyndham Hasler, *d.* on 31 January 1958, and was father of :
 - 5a) **SIR JULIAN HENRY HALL, 11TH BARONET OF DUNGLASS**, *b.* on 22 February 1907, and succeeded his father. He *d.* unmarried on 28 January 1974, and was succeeded by his distant cousin and heir male, Lionel Red Hall, (*see above*).
 - 5a) Agnes Helen Hall, *d.* unmarried on 22 September 1954.
 - 5a) Magdalen Harriet Hall, *b.* on 4 April 1876.
6. Anna Jane Hall, *b.* on 3 January 1826.
