

HEPBURN

OF COLQUHALZIE

JOHN HEPBURN OF COLQUHALZIE, acquired the lands of Colquhalzie from Robert Bisset of Colquhalzie and was father of :

1. Thomas Hepburn of Colquhalzie, (*see below*).
2. Helen Hepburn, *m.* at Blackhill on 18 October 1766, to Adam Stewart of Blackhill, (*c/m* at Colquhalzie on 24 October 1766. He *d.* on 20 December 1811), and *d.* at Colquhalzie on 3 June 1816,¹ having had issue :
 - 2a) Duncan Stewart, *c.* at Perth on 12 November, 1767, and *dsp.*
 - 2a) John Stewart, *c.* at Perth on 24 May, 1773, and *dsp.*
 - 2a) Thomas Stewart, *c.* at Perth on 4 August, 1778, and *dsp.*
 - 2a) Robert Stewart, *c.* at Dull on 9 December, 1776, and *dsp.*
 - 2a) Margaret Stewart, *c.* at Perth on 14 September, 1769, and *dsp.*
 - 2a) Mary Stewart of Blackhill, *b.* 24 November, 1770, and succeeded her father in the lands of Blackhill. She *d.* unmarried on 24 March 1825.
 - 2a) Dorothy Stewart, *c.* at Dull on 9 December 1776, and *d.* young.
 - 2a) Helen Stewart of Blackhill, *c.* at Dull on 13 March 1779, and *m.* at Black hill on 19 September 1815, to her cousin John Hepburn of Colquhalzie,² (he *d.* at Colquhalzie on 20 September 1872³). She was retoured heir to her sister Mary in the lands of Blackhill, Cluny and others on 28 February 1853, and *dsp* at Colquhalzie on 21 April 1874.⁴
 - 2a) Ann Stewart, *c.* at Dull on 3 July, 1781, and *dsp* in September of 1857.
 - 2a) Dorothy Stewart, *c.* at Dull on 18 November 1782, *m.* at Perth on 18 March 1817, James Stewart Robertson, 4th of Derculich,⁵ (he *d.* in February of 1859), and had issue;
 - 2b) **JAMES STEWART ROBERTSON, OF EDRADYNATE & COLQUHALZIE**, *b.* on 15 May 1823, and succeeded to the lands of Colquhalzie on the death of John Hepburn of

Colquhalzie in September of 1872. He *m.* on 27 April 1852, Mary Jane, daughter of Robert Cunningham of Ballanoris, (she *d.* on 29 April 1866), *d.* on 3 August 1896, and had issue,

2c) **JAMES STEWART ROBERTSON, OF EDRADYNATE AND COLQUHALZIE**, *b.* on 14 November, 1856, and *m.* on 11 September, 1880, to Beatrice, daughter of Thomas Murray Allan of Glenfeochan, (she *d.* on 22 January 1946). He *d.* on 14 February 1940, and was father of,

2d) **DOROTHY CAMPBELL STEWART-ROBERTSON, OF EDRADYNATE & COLQUHALZIE**, *b.* on 24 August 1891, and *m.* on 8 February 1921, Lieutenant-Colonel Walter Loyd Sinclair Meiklejohn, (he *d.* on 11 October 1963). They had issue;

2e) James Stewart Meiklejohn, *b.* on 2 October 1922.

2c) Margaret Cunningham Stewart Robertson, *b.* on 26 April 1855, and *d.* unmarried on 4 February, 1940.

2c) Dorothea Stewart Robertson, a twin with Margaret and was *b.* on 26 April 1855. She *d.* unmarried on 24 May 1939.

2c) Mary Stewart Robertson, *bap.* at Edinburgh on 5 May 1861, and *d.* unmarried on 23 November 1933.

2c) Florence Sophia Stewart Robertson, *bap.* at Edinburgh on 6 August, 1864, and *d.* in 1891.

2c) Helen Stewart Robertson, *bap.* at Edinburgh on 10 April, 1866, and *d.* unmarried on 20 July, 1945.

2b) Helen Hepburn Robertson, *b.* on 3rd and *c.* at Logierait on 20 February 1818.

2b) Margaret Stewart Robertson, *b.* on 1st and *c.* at Logierait on 24 November 1819, and *m.* at Edradynate on 14 March 1844 to Captain Robert Scott, H.E.I.C.S.¹

2b) Mary Ann Stewart Robertson, *c.* at Logierait on 5 September 1821, and *d.* on 28 February 1845.²

THOMAS HEPBURN, 2ND OF COLQUHALZIE, succeeded his father and *m.* on 1 July 1781, to Mary Johnston, (she *d.* at Colquhalzie on 16 January 1844³). He *d.* at Colquhalzie on 26 November 1814,⁴ and was father of :

JOHN HEPBURN, 3RD OF COLQUHALZIE, *c.* at Trinty Gask on 1 August 1783, and was infert in the fee of the lands of Colquhalzie on his father's resignation on 3 August 1803. He *m.* at Blackhill on 19 September 1815, to Helen, daughter and eventual heiress of Adam Stewart of Blackhill and Clunie, (she *dsp* at Colquhalzie on 21 April 1874, aged 96 years¹). He *dsp* at Colquhalzie on 20 September 1872,² and was succeeded by his cousin James Stewart Robertson of Edradynate.
