OF ARGATY AND LUNDIES

GEORGE HOME, 1ST OF ARGATY, was a younger son of Sir Patrick Home, 1st of Polwarth, and had a Charter of confirmation for the lands of Rednoch, Incheno, Argaty and Lundie following upon a resignation made in his favour by his mother Margaret Schaw, Lady Direlton, on 28 August, 1526. He *m.* Margaret, natural daughter of Robert, 3rd Lord Erskine, (*c/m* 24 August 1528¹), *d.* prior to 24 August 1568, and was father of :

1. Alexander Home, 2nd of Argaty, (*see below*).
2. David Home, appointed Tutor to his nephew Alexander Home of Argaty and became a Merchant and Burgess in Perth. He was executed with his brother Patrick Home in 1584 for having remained in communication with David Erskine, Commendator of Dryburgh, during his period of forfeiture.
3. Patrick Home, executed with his brother David Home, in 1584.

He was also father of a natural son :

4. George Home, who had Letters of Legitimation under the Great Seal on 24 January, 1556.²

ALEXANDER HOME, 2ND OF ARGATY, had a Charter of confirmation under the Great Seal for the lands of Lundie and Argaty on 5 March, 1556, upon his father's resignation in his favour.³ He *m.* Mariote, daughter of Sir John Campbell, 5th of Glenorchy, (*c/m* at Edinburgh on 27 November, 1558.⁴ She *m.* secondly in 1564, Donald Campbell of Dronkie), *d.* by 1564 and had issue :

PATRICK HOME, 3RD OF ARGATY, succeeded his father in these lands and had the Gift of the escheat of John Hamilton of Bothwellhaugh and his brother David Hamilton on 24 August, 1568.¹ He *m.* firstly, Margaret Anderson, and secondly at Stirling on 27 January 1590, Margaret, daughter of Robert Haldane of Balwill, and *d.* in January of 1629. He was father of :

1. Henry Home, 4th of Argaty, (*see below*).
2. Scipio Home, *bap.* at Stirling on 12 October 1589.

HENRY HOME, 4TH OF ARGATY, had a Disposition for the lands of Rednoch, Argaty and Lundie, from his father on 9 July, 1618,² and to whom he was served heir on 13 March, 1629. He was also served heir to his great-uncle Patrick Home of Corriecrombie, on the same day and had a Disposition for the lands of Argaty from the superior David Erskine, Lord Cardross, on 24 March, 1640.³ He *m.* in around 1625, Mary Muschet and was father of :

1. **GEORGE HOME, 5TH OF ARGATY**, had a disposition for the lands of Argaty with the mill, from his father on 2 September, 1642,⁴ and which lands he granted to his younger brother John Home on 12 October, 1659. He *dsp.*
2. Patrick Home, *bap.* at Kilmadock on 24 July, 1631, and *dsp* prior to October of 1659.
3. **JOHN HOME, 6TH OF ARGATY**, had a Disposition from his brother George Home of Argaty for the lands of Argaty on 12 October, 1659,⁵ and attained the rank of Major in the army. He *m.* at Dunblane on 17 March, 1666, Jean, daughter of David Drummond, 1st of Innermay, (she was widow of James Pearson, 1st of Kippenross, by whom she had issue) and *dsp* on 30 June, 1670.⁶
4. Henry Home, 7th of Argaty, (*see below*).
5. Alexander Home, *bap.* at Kilmadock on 23 November, 1635.
6. William Home, *bap.* at Kilmadock on 25 November, 1642.
7. Margaret Home, *bap.* at Kilmadock on 1 July, 1627.

HENRY HOME, 7TH OF ARGATY, *bap.* at Kilmadock on 27 July, 1633, had a disposition for the lands of Argaty from his brother John Home of Argaty on 18 June, 1670,¹ and for which he had a charter under the Great Seal dated 9 December 1681. He *m.* Janet, daughter of David Moir, 1st of Leckie, (*c/m* 14 November, 1677²), *d.* in July of 1689 and was father of :

1. David Home, *bap.* at Kilmadock on 10 February, 1680, and *d.* young.
2. George Home, 8th of Argaty, (*see below*).
3. **MARY HOME, 9TH OF ARGATY**, who had, with her sisters, a Disposition for the lands of Argaty as heirs portioners to their grandfather Henry Home of Argaty on 11 September, 1751.³ She *m.* George Stewart of Ballachallan, and had issue which succeeded to the lands of Argaty. (*See Stewart of Ballachallan*).
4. Margaret Home, *bap.* at Kilmadock on 10 February, 1680.
5. Katherine Home, *bap.* at Kilmadock on 23 September, 1684.
6. Jean Home, *bap.* at Kilmadock on 16 March, 1689, *m.* William Govan of Boquhapple, and had issue.

GEORGE HOME, 8TH OF ARGATY, *bap.* at Kilmadock on 12 March, 1687, and was served heir to his father on 17 September, 1700. He *dsp* at Leith on 19 December 1750,⁴ and was succeeded by his nephew, David Stewart, eldest son of his eldest sister, Mary.
