

# KEYAY

## OF SNAIGOW

**JAMES KEAY OF SNAIGOW**, *m.* Elizabeth Rankine, (she *d.* at Perth on Tuesday 22 July 1799<sup>1</sup>), and was father of :

1. James Keay of Snaigow, (*see below*).
2. Alexander Keay, became an Accountant in Edinburgh and *dsp*, his brother James being served his heir on 19 February 1808.
3. Andrew Keay, became a Merchant in Perth and *d.* at Stanley on 28 November 1787.<sup>2</sup>
4. Barbara Keay, to whom her nephew, James Keay of Snaigow, was served heir general on 6 July 1829.

**JAMES KEAY OF SNAIGOW**, was served heir general to his brother Alexander Keay, accountant in Edinburgh, on 19 February 1808. He *m.* at Edinburgh on 4 June 1769, to Katherine, daughter of John Glass, Postmaster in Stirling,<sup>3</sup> (she *d.* at Edinburgh in December 1777<sup>4</sup>), *d.* on 10 March 1810, and was father of :

**JAMES KEAY OF SNAIGOW**, became an Advocate, succeeded his father on his death and was served his heir in the lands of Milton of Fornought and Easter and Wester Tullieneadies on 22 June 1810. He *m.* at St. Andrews on 31 October 1816, to Elizabeth, daughter of Robert Graham of Fintry,<sup>5</sup> (she *d.* at Snaigow House on 14 December 1873, aged 85 years<sup>6</sup>), and *d.* at Snaigow on 31 August 1837,<sup>7</sup> the lands of Snaigow afterwards being possessed by his widow until being sold to William Cox, merchant in Dundee.
