

KINNEAR OF LOCHTON

PATRICK KINNEAR OF LOCHTON, acquired the lands of Lochton, in the parish of Longforgan, in Perthshire, in 1795, and *m.* on 30 April 1776, to Elizabeth, daughter of James Hunter, and sister of Thomas Hunter, 1st of Glencarse,¹ (she *d.* at Lochton on 3 March 1824, aged 76 years²). He *d.* at Lochton on 5 March 1833,³ and was father of :

1. Patrick Kinnear of Lochton, (*see below*).
2. Margaret Kinnear, *bap.* on 15 October 1778.
3. Anne Kinnear, *b.* on 10 September 1784.

PATRICK KINNEAR OF LOCHTON, *bap.* on 14 April 1782, succeeded his father and was served his heir in the lands of Lochton and Easter and Wester Newton, being parts of the barony of Baledgarno, in Perthshire, on 19 September 1833. He *d.* at Lochton on Tuesday 23 November 1847, in his 65th year,⁴ having *m.* firstly, at Pitfour on 4 November 1811, to Elizabeth, daughter of Patrick Hill,⁵ (she *d.* of the effects of child-birth at Littleton on 3 November 1826⁶), by whom he had issue :

1. Patrick Kinnear, younger of Lochton, *b.* on 7 March 1818, and *d.* at South Corston on 28 September 1841.⁷
2. Robert Hill Kinnear, (*see below*).
3. Agnes Kinnear, *b.* on 28 July 1812.
4. Elizabeth Hunter Kinnear, *b.* on 16 April 1822, and *d.* at Bridge of Allan on 29 November 1861.¹

5. Janet Kinnear, *b.* on 7 December 1824, and *d.* at Lochton House on 22 January 1850, in her 25th year.²

6. A daughter, who was still-born on 3 November 1826.³

He *m.* secondly on 12 April 1831, to Margaret Matthew,⁴ (she survived him and *d.* at Barossa Place, Perth, on 22 August 1857⁵), and by her he was father of :

7. James Kinnear, *b.* on 31 March 1834, and *d.* at Melbourne, Australia, on 9 April 1875.⁶ He *m.* George Margaret, daughter of Robert J. Jeffray, Banker in Australia, (she survived him and *m.* secondly, to Edward Fraser Sandemen, by whom she had further issue), and was father of :

7a) Robert Hill Kinnear, *b.* in Victoria, Australia, in 1879.

8. Margaret Kinnear, *b.* on 5 January 1833, and *d.* at London Street, Edinburgh, on 2 December 1859.⁷

9. Anne Kinnear, *b.* on 27 March 1836, and *m.* at Gloucester Place, Edinburgh, on 8 June 1864, to Thomas Coventry Wotherspoon.⁸

ROBERT HILL KINNEAR, *b.* on 24 February 1820, and *m.* at Rose Angle, Dundee, on 6 July 1847, to Rosa Magdalena Catherine, youngest daughter of George Louis Korn, Hamburg.⁹ He *d.* at Kew, Victoria, Australia, on 12 April 1902,¹⁰ and was father of :

ROBERT SHIELL KINNEAR, *b.* on 27 September 1851, and *d.* on 2 May 1925.
