

KININMONT

OF CALLINCHE

1. James Kinninmont in Callinch, (*see below*).
2. Mr. Andrew Kinninmont, was *k.* at the battle of Pinkie in September 1547, with his brother being entered in his lands of Ceres as his heir on 6 November 1548.¹

MR. JAMES KINNINMONT IN CALLINCHE, was appointed one of the Tutors of Andrew Kinninmont of that Ilk, in 1526, and had Sasine for the lands of Ceres as heir to his deceased brother Mr. Andrew Kinninmont on 6 November 1548.² He was succeeded by :

Patrick Kinninmont of Callinch, m. Margaret, daughter of Sir Alexander Bruce, 1st of Earlsball.

PATRICK KINNINMONT OF CALLINCHE, m. Helen Wood, by 17 March 1566, when they had an alienation from Archibald Duddingston of Kilduncan for the lands of Kilduncan.³ He was father of,

1. Mr. Walter Kinninmont of Callinch, (*see below*).
2. Gideon Kinninmont,
3. Sara Kinninmont, m. Robert Arnot, eldest son and heir of Peter Arnot of Balcormo, (*c/m* 2, 3, 6, 7 & 9 June 1593⁴).

MR. WALTER KINNINMONT OF CALLINCHE, named with his brother Gideon and their parents in a contract between them on on the one part, and Andrew Kinninmont of that Ilk on the other dated 30 January 1591,⁵ and was retoured heir to his father in the lands of Kilduncan on 8 March 1628.¹
