

# LAUDER

## OF FOUNTAINHALL & GRANGE

**SIR JOHN LAUDER OF NEWINGTON & 1<sup>ST</sup> BARONET OF FOUNTAINHALL**, is generally believed to have been a son of Andrew Lauder at Melville Mill, and was a successful merchant and bailie in Edinburgh. He acquired the lands of Templehalls, Huntlaw, Dryburghland and others in the regality of Torphichen, and other lands in the parishes of Haddington and Cranston, in which he and had son, John Lauder, Advocate, were infest on 13 August 1681, and which were then united into the baron of Fountainhall,<sup>1</sup> and was created a Baronet of Nova Scotia in 1688 with remainder to the heirs male of his own body. He was buried in the Greyfriars, Edinburgh, on 7 April 1692,<sup>2</sup> having *m.* firstly, at Edinburgh on 20 November 1639, to Marion Spears<sup>3</sup> by whom he was father of :

9. James Lauder, *bap.* at Edinburgh on 29 April 1666, and was buried in the Greyfriars on 25 April 1672.<sup>1</sup>
10. Walter Lauder, *bap.* at Edinburgh on 15 November 1667.
11. Charles Lauder, was buried in the Greyfriars, Edinburgh, on 5 January 1675.<sup>2</sup>

**SIR JOHN LAUDER, 2<sup>ND</sup> BARONET OF FOUNTAINHALL**, *b.* on 2 August 1646, and led a legal life, being admitted an Advocate on 5 June 1668, and raised to a Lord of Session in 1689 as Lord Fountainhall. He *d.* on 20 September 1722, having *m.* firstly, at Edinburgh on 21 January 1669, to Janet, daughter of Sir Andrew Ramsay of Abbotshall,<sup>7</sup> (she was buried in the Greyfriars, Edinburgh, on 3 March 1686<sup>8</sup>), by whom he was father of :

3. Alexander Lauder, *bap.* at Edinburgh on 14 June 1679, and to whom his half-brother, Robert Lauder, was served heir 16 April 1724.
4. Andrew Lauder, *bap.* at Edinburgh on 7 October 1681.
5. George Lauder, *bap.* at Edinburgh on 27 February 1683.

**SIR JOHN LAUDER, 3<sup>RD</sup> BARONET OF FOUNTAINHALL**, succeeded his father and was served heir to him on 14 May 1723. He *m.* at Edinburgh on 10 August 1696, to Margaret, daughter of Sir Alexander Seton, 1<sup>st</sup> Baronet of Pitmeddan,<sup>2</sup> *d.* in February of 1728, and was father of :

1. **SIR ALEXANDER LAUDER, 4<sup>TH</sup> BARONET OF FOUNTAINHALL**, succeeded his father and *dsp* on 17 May 1730.

**SIR ANDREW LAUDER, 5<sup>TH</sup> BARONET OF FOUNTAINHALL**, succeeded his father and was served his heir male in the barony of Fountainhall on 27 October 1731. He *m.* Isabella, daughter and heiress of William Dick of Grange, *d.* at Fountainhall on 5 March 1769,<sup>4</sup> and was father of :

**SIR ANDREW DICK LAUDER, 6<sup>TH</sup> BARONET OF FOUNTAINHALL AND GRANGE**, *b.* on 28 April 1743, succeeded his father and was served his heir in the lands of Templehall and parts of the barony of Cranston, on 14 April 1777. He was also served heir general to his mother on 24 March 1779. He *m.* at Edinburgh on 18 October 1783, to Elizabeth, eldest daughter of Thomas Brown of Johnstonburn,<sup>3</sup> *d.* at Fountainhall on 17 December 1820,<sup>4</sup> and was father of :

1. Sir Thomas Dick Lauder, 7<sup>th</sup> Baronet of Fountainhall and Grange, (*see below*).
2. Agnes Dick Lauder, *c.* 7 September 1785.

**SIR THOMAS DICK LAUDER, 7<sup>TH</sup> BARONET OF FOUNTAINHALL AND GRANGE**, *b.* on 13 August 1784, succeeded his father and was served his heir in the lands of Scheynes, St. Geillie, Grange and others, on 1 March 1821. He *m.* at Regulas on 8 February 1808, to Charles Anne, only child and heiress of George Cumin of Regulas,<sup>5</sup> (she *d.* on 22 November 1864), *d.* at Grange House on Monday 29 May 1848,<sup>6</sup> and was father of :

1. Sir John Dick Lauder, 8<sup>th</sup> Baronet of Fountainhall and Grange, (*see below*).

Innes, youngest son of William Mitchell Innes of Ayton<sup>1</sup>). He *d.* at Great Tew Vicarage, Oxon, on 23 February 1850.<sup>2</sup>

**SIR JOHN DICK LAUDER, 8<sup>TH</sup> BARONET OF FOUNTAINHALL AND GRANGE,** *b.* at Regulas on 21 April 1813, and *m.* at Cleland, Lanarkshire, on 22 May 1845, to Anne, second daughter of North Dalrymple of Cleland,<sup>8</sup> (she *d.* at Grosvenor Street, Edinburgh, on 10 August 1919, in her 100<sup>th</sup> year<sup>9</sup>). He *d.* at Bournemouth on 23 May 1867,<sup>10</sup> and was father of :

1. **SIR THOMAS NORTH DICK LAUDER, 9<sup>TH</sup> BARONET OF FOUNTAINHALL AND GRANGE**, *b.* on 28 April 1846, and succeeded his father on his death in 1867. He *d.* unmarried at his villa in Florence, Italy, on 19 June 1919.<sup>1</sup>
2. John Edward Arthur Dick Lauder of Huntlywood, *b.* at Grange House on 28 July 1848, and *m.* on 14 October 1873, to Rosa Caldecott. He *d.* on 27 June 1913. He was father of :
  - 2a) Zella Evelyn Dick Lauder, *b.* on 20 October 1875, *m.* at Holy Trinity Church, Brompton, Saturday on 29 October 1904, to Arthur George Leather-Culley, and *d.* on 8 September 1957.

**SIR GEORGE WILLIAM DALRYMPLE DICK LAUDER, 10<sup>TH</sup> BARONET OF FOUNTAINHALL**, *b.* at Douglas, Isle of Man, on 4 September 1852, and succeeded his brother Sir Thomas on his death without issue in 1919. He did not immediately succeed

to the lands of Grange as the succession was contested by the daughters of his elder brother on the basis that they were heritable via an heir-female. The ruling, though, was in his favour, following which he took possession. He *d.* at Edinburgh on 7 May 1936,<sup>1</sup> *m.* firstly, to Jane Emily Clifford Woodward, (she *d.* at Edinburgh on Monday 22 August 1921<sup>2</sup>), by whom he had issue :

**SIR JOHN NORTH DALRYMPLE DICK LAUDER, 11<sup>TH</sup> BARONET OF FOUNTAINHALL**, *b.* on 22 July 1883, and succeeded his father on his death in 1936. He *m.* on 24 February 1914, to Phyllis Mary, daughter of Brigadier-General Augustus Iggulden, *d.* on 19 September 1958, and was father of :

1. David John Dick Lauder, *b.* on 10 February 1915, and *d.* unmarried on 14 January 1943.

2. Sir George Andrew Dick Lauder, 12<sup>th</sup> Baronet of Fountainhall, (*see below*).

3. Patricia Mary Dick Lauder, was twin with her brother George and was *b.* on 17 November 1917. She *m.* at St. Andrew's Church, Tain, on 11 June 1940, to Captain Alastair George Charles Davy,<sup>3</sup> from whom she was divorced in 1970, and had issue.

**SIR GEORGE ANDREW DICK LAUDER, 12<sup>TH</sup> BARONET OF FOUNTAINHALL**, *b.* on 17 November 1917, and succeeded his father on his death in 1958. He *m.* at St. Andrew's Cathedral, Inverness, on 13 November 1945, to Hester Marguerite, daughter of Lieutenant-Colonel Cecil Minett Sorel-Cameron,<sup>4</sup> *d.* on 11 August 1981, and was father of :

1. Sir Piers Robert Dick Lauder, 13<sup>th</sup> Baronet of Fountainhall, (*see below*).
