

ROLLO

OF WOODSIDE

THOMAS ROLLO, was third son of David Rollo of Powis. He was admitted an Advocate and is styled as lawful son and executor dative to the deceased Mr. David Rollo of Powis in an Obligation between he and Alexander Crichton of Naughton dated 5 March 1582.¹ He and his brother, David Rollo of Powis, and their mother, Marjory Livingstone, entered into a contract with John Andrew, Writer, on 10 March 1588. He *m.* Annabel Forrester, (she was widow of James Sinclair of Banks), and was father of,

1. My Henry Rollo, 1st of Woodside, (*see below*).
2. John Rollo, *bap.* on 7 March 1596 and *d.* in infancy.
3. John Rollo, *bap.* on 18 April 1599.
4. George Rollo, *bap.* on 12 August 1600.
5. Jean Rollo, *bap.* on 2 August 1601.

MR. HENRY ROLLO, 1ST OF WOODSIDE, became a Minister in Edinburgh and *m.* Helen, fourth daughter of Alexander, 4th Lord Elphinstone, (she was widow of Sir William Cockburn of Langton, by whom she had issue), with whom he had a charter for the lands of Larbertsheills and Woodside from Thomas Bruce of Woodside and Elizabeth Rollo his spouse on 13 September 1636.² He *d.* on 2 June 1649³ and was father of,

JOHN ROLLO, 2ND OF WOODSIDE, succeeded his father on his death in 1649. He *m.* at Edinburgh on 7 August 1656, to Elizabeth Oswald,¹ (she survived him and *m.* secondly, to Archibald Douglas of Cliftonhall²), and *d.* in December of 1661.³ He was father of,

1. Sir Henry Rollo, 3rd of Woodside, (*see below*).
2. Andrew Rollo, is styled as second son in his father's Testament in 1661 and served as a Captain in the army. He *dsp*, his brother Sir Henry Rollo of Woodside being served heir to him on 30 July 1697.⁴
3. Helen Rollo, is named in her father's Testament in 1661.

SIR HENRY ROLLO, 3RD OF WOODSIDE, succeeded his father and was served heir to him in the lands of Larbertschiells on 5 July 1674,⁵ and afterwards to his grandfather, Mr. Henry Rollo, in those of Woodside on 11 July 1729. He *m.* Margaret, eldest daughter of John Young of Leny, (*c/m* 1 November 1687⁶), *d.* at Duncrub on 11 April 1733, aged 75 years,⁷ and was father of :

1. Mary Rollo, *bap.* at Crammond on 5 June 1685 and *m.* on 10 May 1702, to Robert Rollo, 4th Lord Rollo, (*c/m* 4 June 1702. He *d.* on 8 March, 1758). She *d.* at Perth on 16 April 1765 and had issue.
2. Margaret Rollo, *bap.* at Crammond on 21 June 1688 and *dvp.*
3. Anna Rollo, *bap.* at Crammond on 7 June 1690 and *dvp.*
