ARCHIBALD STIRLING, 1ST OF GARDEN, *b.* at Garden on 21 March 1651 and to whom his father, Sir Archibald Stirling of Keir, assigned the lands of Garden. He *m.* firstly on 1 April 1677, to Margaret, only daughter of Sir Gideon Baillie of Lochend, (she was widow of Sir John Colquhoun, 2nd Baronet of Luss, and *d.* in childbirth on 20 July 1679), and secondly on 26 January 1686, to Anna, daughter of Sir Alexander Hamilton of Hags. He *d.* in August of 1715 and was father of,

1. **ARCHIBALD STIRLING, 2ND OF GARDEN**, *b.* on 20 July 1679, succeeded his father and was served heir to him in the lands of Garden on 20 November 1717. He *m.* in 1712, Elizabeth Jones and *d.* without surviving male issue in August of 1732.
2. James Stirling, *dsp* prior to 1701.
3. John Stirling, 3rd of Garden, (see below).
4. James Stirling, *b.* on 11 May 1692 and became an agent of the Leadhills Mining Company. He *m.* Barbara, daughter of John Watson of Thirtyacres, and had issue,
 - 4a} Christina Stirling, was served heir to her mother and her maternal aunts, Liliias and Ann Watson, on 1 and 5 July 1763.
5. Charles Stirling, *dsp*.
6. Mariote Stirling, *bap.* at Dunblane on 2 August 1690.

8. Margaret Stirling, who *dsp* prior to 22 May 1716, when her sisters Ann, Elizabeth and Mary were served heirs to her.
9. Elizabeth Stirling,

JOHN STIRLING, 3RD OF GARDEN, succeeded his half brother, Archibald, on his death in 1732 and was served heir to his mother, Ann Hamilton, on 22 October 1740. He *m.* on 8 January 1737, to Grizel, daughter of Robert Graham of Gartmore,¹ (she *d.* in May of 1751), *d.* in 1760 and was father of,

1. Archibald Stirling, 4th of Garden, (*see below*).
2. Robert Stirling, entered the army and *dsp* at the Cape of Good Hope in 1765.
3. James Stirling, *d.* unmarried while in Jamaica.
4. Isabel Stirling, *b.* in 1742 and *d.* unmarried.
5. Ann Stirling, *b.* in 1747 and *d.* unmarried at Garden on 7 February 1825.²

ARCHIBALD STIRLING, 4TH OF GARDEN, *b.* in January 1738 and succeeded his father in 1760. He *m.* at Edinburgh on 11 November 1770, to his cousin, Christian, daughter of his uncle James Stirling,³ (she *d.* in September of 1772), *d.* at Garden on 5 January 1824⁴ and was father of,

JAMES STIRLING, 5TH OF GARDEN, *b.* on 3 September 1772 and succeeded his father in 1824. He *m.* on 16 January 1844, to Isabella, daughter of William Monteith,⁵ (she *d.* at Garden on 10 September 1886, aged 82 years⁶), *d.* at Garden on 20 June 1856⁷ and was father of,

JAMES STIRLING, 6TH OF GARDEN, *b.* on 24 January 1844 and succeeded his father on his death in 1856. He *m.* on 30 September 1875, to Anna Selina, second

daughter of Gartside-Gartside-Tipping of Rossferry, (she *d.* at Sandholes, Kippen, on 7 February 1925¹), *d.* at Garden on 10 March 1906² and had issue,

1. Archibald Stirling, 7th of Garden, (*see below*).
2. Jean Isabel Stirling, *d.* unmarried in 1945.
2. Christian Stirling, *b.* on 14 January, 1879, and *m.* on 7 July, 1903, Colonel Herbert Lionel Showers. They had issue.
3. Mildred Eleanor Stirling, *m.* on 3 October 1900 to David Baxter Maitland, eldest son of E. F. Maitland of Hazel Hall, Dundee, and *d.* as a result of an accident on 19 August 1944, leaving issue.
4. Anna Helen Stirling, *m.* at Edinburgh on 4 June 1907, to Rev. William Atchinson of Drummorie,³ (he *d.* on 24 May 1950). She *d.* on 20 April 1963.
5. Katherine Liliast Stirling, *d.* unmarried at Greenside Cottage, St. Andrews, on 12 April 1934.⁴
6. Marion Grizel Stirling, *d.* unmarried on 19 February 1963.

ARCHIBALD STIRLING, 7TH OF GARDEN, the only son, was *b.* on 29 November 1885 and succeeded his father on his death in 1906. He *m.* at Comrie on Saturday 14 December 1929, to Marjory Lili MacLaren, daughter of William Stewart, 13th of Ardvorlich,⁵ *d.* at Sandyholes, Kippen, on 5 February 1947⁶ and had issue,

1. **JAMES STIRLING, 7TH OF GARDEN**, *b.* on 8 September 1930 and succeeded his father in 1947. He *m.* on 9 August 1958, to Fiona Janetta Sophia, daughter of Lieutenant-Colonel Douglas Alwyn Charles Wood-Parker of Keithock, and had issue.
