

# STIRLING

## OF REDHALL

**ARCHIBALD STIRLING OF REDHALL**, was descended from Stirling of Auchyle but the exact details of this relationship are unproven. He is named in 1677, and was father of,

**ALEXANDER STIRLING OF REDHALL**, *m.* Mary Stirling and was father of,

1. Archibald Stirling, *bap.* at Saint Ninians on 26 December 1697 and *dsp.*
2. Walter Stirling, *bap.* at Saint Ninians on 31 August 1701 and *dsp.*
3. James Stirling of Redhall, (*see below*).
4. John Stirling, *bap.* at Saint Ninians on 4 December 1709 and was apprenticed to Alexander Anderson, Coppersmith in Edinburgh, on 23 December 1724.<sup>1</sup> He *dsp.* his nephew Alexander Stirling being served heir to him on 5 June 1765.
5. Mary Stirling, *bap.* at Saint Ninians on 2 September 1706.

**JAMES STIRLING OF REDHALL**, *bap.* at Saint Ninians on 19 September 1703, and *m.* Janet, daughter of Alexander Gentles, Writer in Falkirk. He was father of,

**ALEXANDER STIRLING**, *b.* on 4 June 1728, and was apprenticed to Robert Leslie, Barber in Edinburgh, on 12 December 1744.<sup>2</sup> He was served heir to his father on 5 June 1765, to his uncle John Stirling on 5 June 1765 and as heir-male to his cousin William Stirling of Herbertshire, firstly, on 20 November 1766, and secondly, on 19 August 1767. He was also served heir to his grandfather Alexander Gentles, Writer in Falkirk, on 20 November 1773.
