JOHN STRANG OF WESTER PITCORTHY, *m.* Cecilia, sister of Richard de Anstruther of that Ilk with whom he had a charter for the lands of Wester Pitcorthy in around 1355.¹ He had a charter for the lands of Easter Pitcorthy from Walter Oliphant of Aberdalgie, on 1 August, 1375,² and as “Lord of Petcorthy,” he had a charter from Isabella Countess of Fife, to the effect that the water of Kethok would march between his lands of Wester Pitcorthy and her lands of Balcarres.³ He was father of,

WALTER STRANG OF PITCORTHY, succeeded to these lands by 22 April, 1444, when he was a member of an assize at the retour of Thomas de Chalmer as heir of William de Chalmer, his father, in the lands of Easter Kinmock, held of the Lord of Kilconquhar.⁴ He was father of,

THOMAS STRANG OF PITCORTHY, succeeded to these lands and *d.* prior to February of 1503. He was father of,

WALTER STRANG OF PITCORTHY, styled as son and heir of Thomas Strang of Pitcorthy when witness to a charter by Margaret Lindsay, relict of Alexander, Earl of Crawford, on 8 January, 1496,⁵ and succeeded his father by 7 February, 1503, when he granted a charter to Mr. John Scrimgeour of Glaster for the lands of Lambethan and Crago, in the Sheriffdom of Forfar. He *d.* by 20 February, 1513, when Elizabeth Ramsay, spouse of the deceased Walter Grundison of Glassie, had a gift of the ward of his daughter and heirs.⁶ He was father of,

1. Geilis Strang, *m.* David Grundison, eldest son and heir of the deceased Walter Grundison of Glassie, and had issue.
2. Agnes Strang, both of whom were coheirs of their father in 1513. She *m.* John Melville of Carnbee.
3. Isabel Strang, infeft in the 32nd part of the lands of Innergeldie as one of the heirs of her father on 8 November, 1526, and *m.* John Clephane of Carselogie, whose relict she is styled in a charter for her share of the lands of Innergeldie to Andrew Wood, on 19 May, 1534.
