

TOSHEOCH

OF PITTENZIE

FINLAY TOSHEOCH, 1ST OF PITTENZIE, was younger son of Duncan Tosheoch of Monzievaird and Isabel Murray, and had acquired the lands of Pittenzie by 9 May, 1516, when he was present at Crieff at retour at the Skait of Crieff of William Moray, as son and apparent heir of William Moray of Castleton, his father, in certain lands.¹ He was father of,

DUNCAN TOSHEOCH, 2ND OF PITTENZIE, succeeded his father, is mentioned in retour of 1544 and was witness to a charter by his kinsman Andrew Tosheoch of Monzie granting the lands of Monzie to Andrew Tosheoch, his son and apparent heir on 5 November, 1553. He was father of,

THOMAS TOSHEOCH, 3RD OF PITTENZIE, who, while still heir apparent of his father, *m.* to Margaret, daughter and heiress of his kinsman John Tosheoch of Culcrieff and had a charter for the shadow half lands of Culcrieff from his father-in-law on 20 February, 1556.² He was father of,

DUNCAN TOSHEOCH, 4TH OF PITTENZIE, had an Instrument of Sasine for the lands of Pittenzie in 1585 and had a charter for the lands of Monzievaird from Edward Tosheoch of Monzievaird on 4 May, 1586. He was witness to a Bond of Manrent entered into between Allaster MacGregor of Glenstrae and Aulay MacAulay of Ardincaple on 27 May, 1591, *m.* a daughter of John Drummond, 5th of Colquhalzie, and *d.* between 26 November, 1604 and 23 January, 1605. He had issue,

JOHN TOSHEOCH, 5TH OF PITTENZIE, had an Instrument of Sasine for the lands of Pittenzie from his father on 26 November, 1604, and was retoured his heir in the lands of

Monzievaird on 23 January, 1605. He *m.* Margaret, daughter of Archibald Campbell, 1st of Lagvinsheoch and Monzie, (*c/m* 22 January, 1636¹), and had Letters of Reversion for the lands of Douglas from James Drummond of Broich on 18 February, 1651. He was father of,

1. **JOHN TOSHEOCH, 6TH OF PITTENZIE**, succeeded his father and *dsp* prior to 9 March, 1668.
2. Duncan Tosheoch, 7th of Pittenzie, (*see below*).

DUNCAN TOSHEOCH, 7TH OF PITTENZIE, succeeded his brother in the lands of Pittenzie and Duchlage and in which he was infeft on 13 June 1668.² He *m.* Marjory Gardner whom he infeft in the liferent of his half lands of Pittenzie in implementation of his contract of marriage on 9 March, 1668,³ and was father of,

ANNA TOSHEOCH, *m.* Alexander MacLaren and which couple obtained the lands of Pittenzie by December of 1682. They had issue, (*see MacLaren of Pittenzie & Broich*).
