

WARDLAW

OF LOGIE

MR. THOMAS WARDLAW, 1ST OF LOGIE, was fourth son of Cuthbert Wardlaw of Balmule and was *bap.* at Dunfermline on 25 September 1569. He is styled as brother to Henry Wardlaw of Balmule in a charter in favour of George Bruce of Sands in 1601¹ and was elected Provost of Dunfermline in which capacity he is found in a Decreet Arbitral dated 8 August 1613.² He acquired the lands of Logie from which he took his designation, and also acquired portions of various other lands in and around Dunfermline including parts of those of Northwaird and Garvock from Henry Waldwood of Northwaird by charter dated 13 March 1622 and a further three acres there named Hallbank from Archibald Douglas, merchant burgher of Dunfermline, by charter of 22 November 1622, both of which were confirmed together under the Great Seal on 24 July 1630.³ He appraised the lands of Rescobbie from James Moultray, son of the deceased Robert Moultray of Markinch, for which he had a charter under the Great Seal dated 26 November 1631.⁴ He *m.* at Dunfermline on 21 July 1601, to Catherine, daughter of Robert Aysoun, or Alison,⁵ *d.* prior to September of 1640 and was father of,

5. Elizabeth Wardlaw, *bap.* at Dunfermline on 26 November 1605.
6. Janet Wardlaw, *bap.* at Dunfermline on 30 June 1607.
7. Catherine Wardlaw, *bap.* at Dunfermline on 13 August 1609 and *d.* young.
8. Isabel Wardlaw, *bap.* at Dunfermline on 5 February 1612.
9. Christian Wardlaw, *m.* at Dunfermline on 12 October 1625, to David Wemyss of Rungay,¹ and had issue.
10. Nanse Wardlaw, *bap.* at Dunfermline on 9 March 1614 and *m.* at Dunfermline on 27 April 1631, to Robert Mercer, 2nd of Kirkland of Saline.² They had issue.
11. Margaret Wardlaw, *bap.* at Dunfermline on 22 July 1616 and *m.* firstly, Mr. to Henry Makgill, Minister of Dunfermline, (he was widow of Isobel Lindsay by whom he had issue), by whom she had issue. She *m.* secondly, to James Reid, Provost of Dunfermline, and had further issue.

WILLIAM WARDLAW, 2ND OF LOGIE, *bap.* at Dunfermline on 23 June 1620, succeeded his father and was served heir to him in the lands of Logie on 12 September 1640.³ He *m.* firstly, at Dunfermline on 15 November 1640, to Margaret, daughter of David Wemyss of Fingask,⁴ by whom he had no apparent issue; and secondly, at Dunfermline on 8 August 1643, to Jean, daughter of Andrew Ker of Brownlands,⁵ (*c/m* 10 July 1643⁶), by whom he was father of;

- 2a) Agnes Scott, *bap.* at Logie on 8 September 1665.
- 2a) Magdalen Scott, *bap.* at Logie on 27 November 1667. She and her sister, Agnes, were served heirs portioners to their cousin Isabella, daughter of Charles Wardlaw of Logie, in the lands of Logie on 6 January 1696.¹
3. Marie Wardlaw, *bap.* at Dunfermline on 29 March 1646.
4. Anna Wardlaw, *bap.* at Dunfermline on 31 October 1647.

CHARLES WARDLAW, 3RD OF LOGIE, *bap.* at Dunfermline on 25 August 1644, and succeeded his father. He *m.* at Dunfermline on 4 April 1672, to Christian, second daughter of Magnus Aytoun, Notary in Burntisland,² (*c/m* 21 March 1672³), *d.* by December of 1682 and was father of,

ISABELLA WARDLAW, 4TH OF LOGIE, *bap.* at Burntisland on 16 April 1675, succeeded her father and was served heir to him in the lands of Logie on 8 December 1682.⁴ She *dsp* prior to 6 January 1696 when her neices, Agnes and Magdalen Scott, were served heirs to her.
