

WELLWOOD

OF TOUCH & GARVOCK

ROBERT WELLWOOD OF TOUCH AND GARVOCK, traded as a merchant in Edinburgh for some years and *m.* in around 1690, to Catherine, daughter of John Denham of Muirhouse and West Shields. He *d.* prior to 28 February 1735, and was father of :

1. **HENRY WELLWOOD OF GARVOCK AND PITLIVER**, *hap.* at Edinburgh on 11 August 1685, succeeded his father and was served heir to him on 28 February 1735. He purchased the estate of Tulliebole from Robert Halliday in 1749 and *dsp* on 16 January 1758, being succeeded by his brother, Robert.
2. Robert Wellwood of Garvock, (*see below*).

ROBERT WELLWOOD OF TOUCH AND GARVOCK, *b.* on 13 and *hap.* at Edinburgh on 25 May 1690, and succeeded his brother, Henry Wellwood, on his death without issue in 1758, being served heir to him in the lands of Tulliebole, and others, on 13 March 1758. He *m.* Susanna, apparently daughter of Mr. Archibald Campbell, Minister of Dalgety, (she *d.* in February of 1766¹), *d.* on 13 April 1767² and was father of :

1. Robert Wellwood of Garvock, (*see below*).
2. Catherine Wellwood, *b.* on 23 May 1722 and *m.* on 13 April 1749, to Rev. Sir William Moncrieff, Minister of Blackford.³ They had issue.

3. Isabel Wellwood, *bap.* at Dunfermline on 3 October 1727 and *m.* James Robertson, W.S, eldest son of George Robertson of Craigarnhall, (*c/m* 10 September 1744). They had issue.
4. Margaret Wellwood, *bap.* at Dunfermline on 7 June 1731 and *m.* on 11 December 1754, to Dr. John Steedman.¹ They had issue.
5. Anna Wellwood, *bap.* at Dunfermline on 7 March 1735.

ROBERT WELLWOOD OF GARVOCK, *b.* on 22 December 1720 and succeeded his father on his death in 1767, being served heir general to him on 4 November 1772. He *m.* Mary, eldest daughter of Sir George Preston, younger of Valleyfield, (*c/m* 29 May 1751. She *d.* at Torryburn House on 21 September 1813²), *d.* on 12 January 1791³ and was father of :

1. **ROBERT WELLWOOD OF GARVOCK**, *b.* on 7 February 1747 and succeeded his father on his death in 1791. He *m.* firstly, on 27 January 1781, to Lillias, daughter of James Robertson Barclay of Keavil, (she *d.* on 17 March 1812⁴), and secondly, on 1 June 1812, to Eliza Isabella MacNeil, (she survived him and *m.* secondly, at Wellwood Lodge on June 1825, to John Winstanley of Leyland⁵). He *d.* at Pitliver on 7 July 1820⁶ having had issue by his first wife ;

1a} Isabella Wellwood, *bap.* at Dunfermline on 12 November 1782, and *m.* at Pitliver on 2 August 1802, to Robert Clarke of Comrie Castle.⁷ She *d.* in 1826, and had issue.

1a} Mary Wellwood, *bap.* at Dunfermline on 4 September 1784, and *m.* at Pitliver House on 12 November 1808, to Lawrence Johnston of Sands.¹

- 1a} Ann Wellwood, *b.* on 10 March 1786.
2. **ANDREW MOFFAT WELLWOOD OF GARVOCK**, *b.* on 8 September 1764 and was served heir male to his brother, Robert Wellwood, in the lands of Touch, Garvock and others on 12 August 1820. He *m.* on 14 March 1794, to Maria, daughter of Martin Taylor of Amble,² (she survived him and *d.* Canaan Park on 1 August 1847³), *d.* at Canaan Park on 25 February 1847,⁴ and was father of,
- 2a} Charles Preston Wellwood, *bap.* at Warkworth, Northumberland, on 7 August 1799 and *dsp.*
- 2a} Anna Mary Wellwood, *m.* first, at Edinburgh on 22 March 1825, to John James Boswell, Advocate,⁵ and had issue ; and secondly, at St. Thomas's Episcopal Chapel, Edinburgh, on 15 April, 1848, to Ralph Clarke, of the Hill, Emsworth.⁶
3. Patrick Wellwood, *b.* on 2 December 1757 and *dsp* in Jamaica.
4. George Wellwood, *b.* on 7 September 1848 and *dsp* at Batavia.
5. Henry Wellwood, *b.* on 10 February 1756 and was lost off the coast of Ireland on the "General Bankes" Indiaman.
6. James Wellwood, *b.* on 15 March 1761 and was *ksp* at the battle of Assaye, in India.
7. Ann Wellwood, *b.* on 4 August 1745 and *m.* at Pitliver House on 30 August 1772, to Robert Scott Moncrieff of Coates and Newhall.⁷ They had issue;
- 7a} **ROBERT WELLWOOD-SCOTT OF GARVOCK**, succeeded his maternal uncle, Andrew Moffat Wellwood of Garvock, and was served heir to

him in parts of the lands of Touch and Garvock on 6 December 1847.

He *dsp* at Pitliver House on 19 June 1854.¹

8. Susan Wellwood, *bap.* at Dunfermline on 27 August 1751 and *d.* unmarried at Edinburgh on 9 December 1839.²

9. Elizabeth Wellwood, *b.* on 21 November 1752 and *m.* Allan MacConnochie, Lord Meadowbank. They had issue;

9a} **ALEXANDER MACCONNACHIE WELLWOOD OF GARVOCK**, succeeded his cousin, Robert Wellwood-Scott, and was served heir to him in the lands of Garvock on 10 August 1854.

10. Catherine Wellwood, *b.* on 12 May 1754 and *d.* unmarried.
