

WEMYSS

OF FOODIE

HENRY WEMYSS OF FOODIE, was a substitute heir to his brother David Wemyss of Fingask in the lands of Collieston on 20 March, 1616.¹ He *m.* Catherine, daughter of David Brown of Finmonth, (*c/m* 16 August, 1619,²) *d.* in August 1652³ and was father of,

1. David Wemyss of Foodie, (*see below*).
2. Robert Wemyss, appointed Tutor to the children of his brother Mr. Patrick Wemyss. He *m.* at Perth on 31 March, 1660, Marjory, daughter of Thomas Blair, 2nd of Tarsappie.
3. Patrick Wemyss of Gladney, obtained the lands of Gladney from Thomas Glover of Gladney on 14 January, 1665,⁴ and *m.* first, on 15 September, 1654, Elizabeth, daughter of Mr. George Hamilton, Minister of Pittnweem, (she *d.* on 5 April, 1662,), by whom he had issue. He *m.* secondly, Janet, daughter of William Durie, portioner of Overgrange, (*c/m* 24 January, 1666.⁵ She *m.* secondly by 14 July, 1670, William Colville, youngest son of Mr. Alexander Colville of Blair.) He *d.* in November of 1667⁶ and was father of,
 - 3a) Henry Wemyss,
 - 3a) George Wemyss,
 - 3a) Euphemia Wemyss,
 - 3a) Elizabeth Wemyss,
 - 3a) Janet Wemyss, the only child by her father's second marriage. She *m.* on 30 April, 1683, to her cousin Mr. Thomas Wemyss, and had issue.
4. James Wemyss of Gladney, appointed Principal of St. Leonards College, St. Andrews, and was infeft in the lands of Gladney on 3 May, 1684.

5. Isabel Wemyss, had a bond from her brother Mr. Patrick Wemyss of Gladney for 1000 merks on 3 October, 1667, which she afterwards assigned to her brotger David Wemyss of Foodie on 24 February, 1669.¹

DAVID WEMYSS OF FOODIE, succeeded his father and *m.* firstly, Agnes, sister of Robert Paterson of Dunmure, by whom he had no apparent issue. He *m.* secondly, in around 1660, Elspeth, daughter of Thomas Blair of Tarsappie, *d.* in January of 1684² and was father of,

1. Henry Wemyss of Foodie, (*see below*).
2. **THOMAS WEMYSS OF FINGASK**, educated at the University of St. Andrews, where he graduated M.A. on 25 July, 1676, and acted as executor to his father on his death in 1684. He *m.* on 30 April, 1683, Janet, daughter of his uncle Mr. Patrick Wemyss of Gladney, and was father of,
 - 2a) **DAVID WEMYSS OF FOODIE AND FINGASK**, succeeded to the Foodie and Fingask estates and was buried in Cupar on 18 January, 1748.

 - 2a) Margaret Wemyss,
 - 2a) Janet Wemyss,
 - 2a) Elizabeth Wemyss,
3. George Wemyss, *bap.* at Dairsie on 3 January, 1668.
4. David Wemyss, *bap.* at Dairsie on 9 November, 1670.
5. Elizabeth Wemyss, *bap.* at Dairsie on 9 November, 1670.

HENRY WEMYSS OF FOODIE, was a child by his father's second marriage and is styled as such in 1686. He was retoured heir to his father in the lands of Wester Foodie on 27 December, 1694, and *dsp* soon after with his brother Dr. Thomas Wemyss succeeding as his heir.
