THOMAS WHITSON OF PARKHILL, *m.* Helen, daughter of Thomas Graham, 4th of Balgowan, and was father of,

1. Thomas Whitson of Parkhill, (*see below*).
2. Andrew Whitson, *c.* at Rattray on 23 March 1720, and *d.* prior to August of 1749.¹
3. Margaret Whitson, *c.* at Rattray on 22 February 1723.
4. Martha Whitson, *c.* at Alyth on 13 September 1726.

THOMAS WHITSON OF PARKHILL, succeeded his father and *m.* on 23 August 1759, to Margaret, daughter of Alexander Hogg of Wester Kinloch. He was father of,

1. **ALEXANDER WHITSON OF PARKHILL**, *c.* on 11 September 1761, and succeeded his father. He *m.* on 28 March 1819, to Sarah Elizabeth, sister and heir of Robert Smyth of Balharry and *dsp* at Parkhill on 20 September 1833, aged 72 years.²
2. Thomas Whitson, (*see below*).
3. George Whitson, *c.* on 23 December 1774, trained for the church and was admitted Minister of Brechin. He *m.* at Brechin on 29 August 1809, Mary, daughter of William Mollison, Provost of Brechin,³ and *dsp* at Parkhill on 23 November 1835, aged 60.⁴
4. James Whitson, *c.* on 21 October 1769, and *d.* in 1788.
5. Agnes Whitson, *c.* on 18 July 1760, and *d.* in 1820.
6. Helen Whitson, *c.* on 14 September 1763, and *d.* in 1768.
7. Marjory Whitson, *c.* on 25 February 1771, and *m.* at Perth on 28 November 1796, to Malcolm Stewart, brother of John Stewart of Sheirglass. They had issue.

THOMAS WHITSON, *c.* on 20 May 1765, and became a Writer in Perth. He *m.* at Errol on 25 August 1805, to Janet Hill, *d.* in 1819 and was father of,

1. **ALEXANDER WHITSON OF PARKHILL**, *b.* at Perth on 6 June 1806, succeeded his uncle and namesake and to whom he was served heir on 31 March 1834. He *dsp* on 20 June 1856, and was succeeded by his brother Thomas.

2. **THOMAS HUNTER WHITSON OF PARKHILL**, *b.* at Perth on 23 November 1809, succeeded his brother Alexander in the lands of Parkhill and to whom he was served heir on 9 December 1857. He was also served heir to (1) his cousin Margaret Hogg, widow of Richard Flanigan Edwards of Wester Kinloch, on 8 December 1856, and (2) to Alexander Hogg of Wester Kinloch on 14 July 1857. He *m.* at St. Luke's, Chelsea, on 10 August 1854, to Emma Victoria, youngest daughter of William Burges, Southsea,¹ (she *d.* at Edinburgh on 24 January 1901²), and *dsp* at Melville Street, Edinburgh, on 19 December 1881,³ being succeeded by his nephew Charles Hill.

3. Agnes Hunter Whitson, *b.* on 28 October 1814, and *m.* at Perth 26 November on 1839, to Charles Hill of Luthrie. She *d.* at Perth on 24 November 1880,⁴ with issue;

3a) **CHARLES HILL-WHITSON OF PARKHILL**, *b.* on 16 December 1840, succeeded his uncle Thomas Hunter Whitson of Parkhill in the lands of Parkhill on his death in 1881 and assumed the surname of Whitson. He *m.* at Edinburgh on 28 February 1871, Beatrice Dudgeon, (she *d.* at Newbury, Berkshire, in 1933, and was buried at Parkhill), and *d.* at Parkhill on 10 March 1913. He was father of,

3b) **THOMAS ERNEST HILL WHITSON OF PARKHILL**, *b.* in 1877, served as Lieutenant-Colonel in the 14th Hussars, and *m.* in 1901, Kathleen, fourth daughter of Colonel MacDonnell. He *d.* at London on 16 February 1925, and was buried at Parkhill on 19 February following. He was father of,

3c) Kenneth Francis Lynedoch Hill Whitson, *b.* in 1904, and *dsp* at London in September of 1924.

3c) Aline Hill Whitson *b.* in 1902, and *m.* in 1924, Lieutenant-Colonel Thomas H. C. Nunn, and succeeded to Parkhill on the death of her father.

3b) Eric Hill Whitson, *b.* in 1879, entered the army and served as Major in the Royal Scots. He *m.* at Ranikhet, Bengal, on 25 August 1910, to Muriel, youngest

daughter of Major Edward Rowland Bennett Stokes Roberts, (she *d.* on 28 February 1947), and *d.* in July of 1924. He was father of,

3c) Torquil Ivan Alec Hill Whitson, *b.* in India, on 8 May 1911, and *m.* firstly, in 1936, to Edith M. Husband. He *m.* secondly, in 1946, to Margaret P. Sanderson.

3b) Lillias Hunter Hill Whitson, *b.* in 1875, and *m.* at Blairgowrie on 23 November 1903, Captain George Humphrey Irving Graham, Devonshire Regiment, (he was *k.* in action in Mesopotamia on 7 January 1916¹). She *d.* at Crieff on 11 December 1953, with issue.

3b) Agnes Hill Whitson, *b.* in 1881, *m.* at Blairgowrie on 10 April 1901, to Captain William Oxenham Cautly, 3rd Suffolk Regiment, (he was *k.* in action in France on 8 May 1915²), and had issue.

3b) Beatrix Hill Whitson, *b.* in 1884.

3b) Marjorie Hill Whitson, *b.* in 1888 and *m.* in 1924, to Admiral Sir Alexander Duff, (he was widow of Janet Douglas, daughter of Garden Duff of Hatton Castle, and *d.* in London on 22 November 1933).
