

# WILLIAMSON

## OF BARNHILL

**JOHN WILLIAMSON OF BARNHILL**, served as Sheriff-Depute for Perthshire and *m.* firstly, Magdalen, daughter of Mr. James Auchinleck, Minister of Kettins, by whom he was father of ;

1. James Williamson of Barnhill, (*see below*).
2. Henry Williamson, *b.* 16 May 1675, and *dsp* young.
3. Katherine Williamson, *b.* 10 November 1676.

He *m.* secondly, on 14 November 1686, Elizabeth, daughter of Patrick Butter of Gormack, (*c/m* 10 November 1686), by whom he had no apparent issue.

He *d.* in November of 1699 and was succeeded in the lands of Barnhill by his only son ;

**JAMES WILLIAMSON OF BARNHILL**, *m.* on 19 April 1694, Katherine, daughter of David Smyth, brother of Patrick Smyth of Methven, (she survived him and *m.* secondly, in 1707, to Sir David Threipland, 2<sup>nd</sup> of Fingask), and was father of,

**MARGARET WILLIAMSON**, *b.* on 5 October 1698, and was retoured heir to her grandfather in the lands of Barnhill on 23 April 1701. She *dsp* in June of 1708, with her cousin Alexander Ragg, son of Captain J. Ragg, Wine Merchant in Aberdeen, being served her heir in the lands of Barnhill, Woodend of Kinnoul and Muirhall, on 2 August 1708.
