OF SAUGHTONHALL, RATHOBYRES

& WHITSON

JAMES WINRAM, PORTIONER OF SAUGHTONHALL & OF WHISTON, *m.* Catherine, sister and heir of William Fisher, Burgess of Edinburgh, with whom he is named in a charter 25 August 1624,¹ and acquired the barony of Woustoun which he had adjudged from John, Lord Torphicen, and Sir John Carmichael of that Ilk, on 13 May 1626, and for which he had a charter under the Great Seal on 6 March 1627.² He disposed his share of the lands of Saughtonhall to Thomas Mudie of Dalry in 1645, *d.* after 28 December 1655, when he had part of his lands of Ratho appraised from him, and prior to 14 March 1659, and was father of :

MR. JAMES WINRAM OF WHISTON, succeeded his father and was served heir to father in the fourth part of the lands of Rathobyres on 14 March 1659, and was ineft as his heir in the east and west lands of Middlerig, in the barony of Thankerton, on 3 June 1661.³ He was father of :

1. Anna Winram, *m.* Allan Lockhart of Cleghorn and *d.* in July of 1742.
2. Elizabeth Winram,
3. Margaret Winram, all of whom were retoured heirs to their father on 7 June 1690.
