

WINTON

OF STRATHMARTINE

ANDREW WINTON OF STRATHMARTINE, of uncertain ancestry, entered into a mutual bond of maintenance with John Campbell of Lundy on 28 March 1565, and *m.* Elspeth, daughter of John Scrimgeour of Dudhope, (*c/m* 27 May 1559.¹ She survived him and *m.* secondly, to John Ogilvy of Pitpointe ; and *d.* in September of 1595²). He *d.* on 10 December 1570, and was father of :

1. Sir Thomas Winton of Strathmartine, (*see below*).
2. Andrew Winton, was witness to his brother Thomas's marriage contract in 1584.

SIR THOMAS WINTON OF STRATHMARTINE, who was under age at his father's death on 10 December 1570, with his ward and that of his lands being granted to Patrick Gardyne of that Ilk, the following day.³ was sheriff principal of the sheriffdom of Forfar in which capacity he is named in a pointing at the instance of Mr. John Ogilvy in Newbigging dated 12 March 1623. He *m.* Isabella, daughter of Peter Hay of Leys, (*c/m* 23 June 1584.⁴ She was widow of Robert Turnbull of Bogmilm whom she had married by *c/m* 2 September 1574), with whom he had a charter from her father for an annualrent to be uplifted from the lands of Strathmartine. He resigned the fee of the lands of Strathmartine, and others, in favour of his eldest son and heir, Andrew Winton, and his spouse, on 26 June 1606, *d.* after 12 March 1623, and was father of :

1. Andrew Winton of Strathmartine, (*see below*).
2. Gilbert Winton, named with his father in a Bond to Gilbert Scrimgeour, brother to John Scrimgeour of Kirkton, dated 29 November 1617.⁵

3. Isabella Winton, *m.* by 9 July, 1616, John Crichton of Innernytie, and *d.* on 3 February 1643.¹

ANDREW WINTON OF STRATMARTIN, *m.* Marjory, daughter of Patrick Ogilvy, younger of Inchmartine, (*c/m* 29 July 1605), with whom he had a charter from his father for the lands of Pitpoyntie and Strathmartine on 26 June 1606.² He was witness with his father, to a charter by William Haliburton of Pitcur on 22 July 1620, and was father of :

PATRICK WINTON OF STRATHMARTINE, styled as younger of Strathmartin when uncluded in a charter dated 10 September 1652, to himself, Robert Nairne of Sandford and Frederick Lyon of Brigton for the 12 oxgangs of the lands of Errol,³ and *m.* by 10 February 1648, Margaret, daughter of James Stewart, 10th of Rosyth.⁴ He was father of :

PATRICK WINTON OF STRATHMARTIN, *m.* Jean, daughter of William Nairne, son of David Nairne of Sandford, (*c/m* 13 December 1670⁵). He *d.* on 3 August 1694, and was father of :

THOMAS WINTON OF STRATHMARTINE, succeeded his father and was retoured his heir in the tennandry of Strathmartine, the lands of Auchinharie, Gulshouses, Balmadoune, Baldragon, Kirkton of Strthmartine, Pitpoyntie and others, on 21 September 1699.⁶ He had the lands of Strathmartin appraised for payments of his creditors in 1727.
