

YEAMAN

OF MURIE

GEORGE YEAMAN, 1ST OF MURIE, was a successful Merchant and Provost of Dundee. He obtained the lands of Murie from Sir John Hay of Murie and in which he was infeft on 14 September, 1709. He *m.* at Errol on 9 April, 1725, Elizabeth, daughter of James Somerville of Drum, and *d.* prior to February of 1733. He was father of,

JAMES YEAMAN, 2ND OF MURIE, retoured heir to his father on 10 February, 1733, and *m.* Margaret, daughter of Sir James Kinloch, 2nd Baronet of Kinloch. He *d.* in August of 1775, and was father of,

1. James Yeaman, 3rd of Murie, (*see below*).
2. George Yeaman, *b.* on 24 June, 1752, became a Merchant in Dundee, and *dsp.* His brother James Yeaman of Murie was retoured his heir-general on 3 February 1807.
3. **JANET YEAMAN, 4TH OF MURIE**, retoured heir to her brother James Yeaman of Murie in the lands of Murie on 7 November 1811. She *dsp* on 18 August 1823, and was succeeded in the lands of Murie by her sister Jean Yeaman.
4. Mary Yeaman, *b.* on 2 September, 1738, and *dsp.*
5. **JEAN YEAMAN, 5TH OF MURIE**, *b.* on 4 May, 1741, and *m.* on 8 August 1772, David Spence, M.D., in Edinburgh. She was retoured heir to her sister in the lands of Murie on 3 March 1824, and *d.* on 26 January 1827. They had issue,
 - 5a) **MARGARET SPENCE YEAMAN, 6TH OF MURIE**, *b.* 18 April 1773. She was retoured heir to her mother in the lands of Murie on 25 June 1828, and to her uncle James Yeaman of Murie in lands around Errol on 16 April 1849. She *dsp* on 3 May 1849, and to whom James Miln of Woodhill was retoured heir in the lands of Murie on 2 August 1849.
 - 5a) Jean Spence, *b.* 21 August 1775.
 - 5a) Mary Spence, *b.* 9 July, 1779.
6. Margaret Yeaman, *b.* on 18 July, 1746, and *d.* unmarried.

JAMES YEAMAN, 3RD OF MURIE, *b.* on 2 April, 1748, and was retoured heir to his father in the lands of Murie, Mains of Errol, Newhall and Whiteriggs on 8 March 1777. He *dsp* on 21 June 1810, and was succeeded by his sister Janet Yeaman.
