

## Miscellaneous Extracts taken during research for the Red Book of Scotland

1. B59/38/6/46.

Testamentary papers of George Oliphant, Provost of Perth, dated 27 March 1703, in which he names Margaret Orrock, his wife, his executor on behalf of their children, Elizabeth, Katherine, Eupham, Margaret and Isabel.

Contains the following inventory of writs;

1. By My Thomas Glas, Minister at Little Dunkeld, and his wife, Agnes Anderson, by virtue of his Testament of 21 May 1694.

2. Factory by Agnes Anderson to Thomas Glass, her eldest son.

3. Decree whereupon Mr. Alexander Glas against John Glas of Sauchie as nephew and heir to John Glas, Provost of Perth.

4. Marriage contract between Alexander Orrock, younger of that Ilk, and Alexander Orrock and Margaret Clayhills, widow of Laurence Oliphant of Pitkeithly, dated 27 April 1669.

5. Marriage contract between George Oliphant and Margaret Orrock, dated 13 June 1693.

The Tutors nominated by George Oliphant to his daughter are Margaret Orrock, his wife, and Laurence Oliphant of Pitkeithly.

2. B59/26/6/1/5.

Appointment of curators at Perth on 21 October 1708, to Elizabeth, Katherine, Margaret and Eupham Oliphant, lawful daughters to the deceased George Oliphant, Provost of Perth. Appointed as nearest kin on the father's side; John Oliphant, elder and younger of Carpow, and on the mother's side: Alexander Orrock of that Ilk and Laurence Oliphant of Pitkeithly.
