EWEN/ANDREW MACPHERSON, brother to Lachlan MacPherson of Cluny, is said to have been father of;

ANDREW MACPHERSON, m. Ellen MacPherson and was father of,

1. James MacPherson of Bellville, (*see below*).
2. Janet MacPherson, m. a Clark and had issue.

JAMES MACPHERSON, 1ST OF BELLVILLE, b. on 27 October 1736, and is best known for his translation of the Ossian legends. He d. on Tuesday 17 February 1795 and was father of,

1. James MacPherson of Bellville, (*see below*).
2. **ANNE MACPHERSON OF BELLVILLE**, succeeded and was served heir to her father and brother, James, in the lands of Glenbuchar, Dalnachelag, Stroan, Raiths, Phoness, Otterish and others on 29 March 1834.¹ She d. unmarried, in July of 1862, being succeeded by her nephew, James MacPherson Brewster.
3. Juliet MacPherson, m. on 31 July 1810, Sir David Brewster, Principal of Edinburgh University, (she d. at Alallerly, near Melrose, on in February of 1868. He survived her and m. secondly, in 1857, Jane, daughter of Thomas Purnell), and d. in 1850, leaving issue
 - 3a} **JAMES MACPHERSON BREWSTER OF BELLVILLE**, who inherited the Belleville estate on the death of his aunt, Ann MacPherson of Bellville, in 1862.

JAMES MACPHERSON, 2ND OF BELLVILLE, entered the H.E.I.C.S. and was served heir of tailzie and provision to his father on 9 May 1798.¹ He *dsp* in April of 1834 and was succeeded by his sister, Ann.
