

## Miscellaneous Extracts taken during research for the Red Book of Scotland

RS10/8/198.

Sasine containing contract of marriage of 13 December 1742, between Alexander Stewart, son of Duncan Stewart of Invernahyle, on the one part, and Katherine, daughter of Robert Stewart of Appin, on the other part, with consent of Ann Campbell, her other, and Dugald Stewart of Appin, her brother.

RS51/5/2.

Sasine in favour of William Murray, younger of Ochertyre, for the lands of Ochertyre on his father's resignation in his favour. Dated 17 November 1657.

RS51/5/9.

Sasine for the lands of East and West Pitgrundie in favour of John Arnot, son and apparent heir to John Arnot of Pitgrundie, reserving the liferent to the said John, elder, and Sara Lyell, his wife. Dated 15 December 1657.

RS51/5/11.

Sasine to John Arnot, younger of Pitgrundie, and Margaret, second daughter of the deceased James Reid, Provost of Dunfermline, in implementation of a marriage contract between them dated 19 December 1657.

RS52/15/23.

Instrument of Sasine for the lands of Tempar, Lassintulloch and others, to James Stewart. Dated 8 February 1705.

RS52/15/26.

Sasine in favour of Patrick Robertson, son and heir to Alexander Robertson of Blairfetty, for the lands of Blairfetty. Dated 3 February 1705.

RS52/15/43.

Sasine in favour of Aeneas Oliphant for the lands of Balgonie. Dated April 1705.

RS52/17/71.

Sasine in favour of Alexander Blair of Corbs for the lands of Corbs as heir to his late father, Andrew Blair of Corbs. Dated 6 December 1716.

RS52/17/72.

Sasine in favour of Andrew Blair, eldest son and heir of Alexander Blair of Corbs, of the lands of Corbs on his father's resignation. Dated 6 December 1716.

RS52/17/88.

Sasine in favour of Robert Drummond, eldest son of George Drummond of Callander, for the lands of Kincardine. Dated 14 January 1717.

RS52/19/18

Sasine in favour of Thomas Butter of Balnabroich and Grisel Menzies, his wife, of the lands of Ballinluig, following on a wadset with the Duke of Atholl, dated 22 August 1719. One witness is Thomas Butter, their son.

CC8/8/13/179.

Testament of John Spalding of Drunclune who died in January of 1580, given up by himself on 3 February 1580, before witnesses including Andrew Spalding of Ashintully.

CC8/8/33/167.

Testament of Christina Blair, wife of Andrew Balvaird in Abernethy, who died in November 1598, given up by the said Andrew as executor, in the name of Janet Balvaird their only child.

CC8/8/326.

Testament of Andrew Arnot in Capildra who died on 11 November 1603, given up by Janet Kilgour, his relict, in the name of Helen Arnot, their only child.

CC20/4/5/601.

Testament of Margaret Schaw, relict of the deceased John Gib in Touchie, who died on 14 October 1614.

CC20/4/6/898.

Testament of Sir Andrew Melville of Garvock who died on 13 April 1617, given up by Elizabeth Hamilton, his relict spouse, in the names of Elizabeth and Helen Melville, their daughters, being minors.

CC20/4/7/836.

Testament of Elizabeth Morton, Lady Rires, who died on 22 December 1620, given iup by James Forbes, her son, as executor.

CC20/4/7/977.

Testament of Mr William Shaw of Pitmurthly who died on 10 January 1621, given up by Isabel Drummond, his relict, as executor.

CC2/5/4/57.

Testament of Margaret Stewart, wife of John Stewart of Ballachuilish, who died in March of 1698.
