

NAPIER

OF CRAIGANNET

FRANCIS NAPIER, 1ST OF CRAIGANNET, was third son of William Napier, 1st of Ardmor. He was served heir-general to his brother Robert Napier in Tangiers on 22 January 1676 and acquired the lands of Craigannet from his nephew, David Liddell of Craigannet. He *m.* Jean Blair, *d.* by October 1712 and was father of,

1. Gabriel Napier, 2nd of Craigannet, (*see below*).
2. Catherine Napier, *b.* on 21 April 1695.

GABRIEL NAPIER, 2ND OF CRAIGANNET, infest in the lands of Craigannet as heir to his deceased father in October of 1712, and became a Writer in Edinburgh. He was included with his son, John, in the remainder of a tailie for the lands of Ballikinrain in 1748. He *m.* Catherine McKell, (she *d.* in July of 1754), *d.* in 1756, and was father of,

1. Robert Napier, *b.* at Edinburgh on 1 March 1721.
2. **JOHN NAPIER, 3RD OF CRAIGANNET**, *b.* at Edinburgh on 19 November 1724, and was included with his father in the remainder of a tailie for the lands of Ballikinrain in 1748. He was served heir general to his father on 18 August 1756,¹ then to his brother Francis in the lands of Kincaid on 10 July 1758, and to his mother in the lands of Prinatoun on 4 August 1758.² He *dsp* in August of 1789, with his sister Helen being served heir to him.³

3. Francis Napier, who *dsp* in 1758 and to whom his brother John was served heir in the lands of Kincaird on 10 July of that year.¹
4. Helen Napier, who was served heir to her brother John in the lands of Kincaid on 23 October 1789, and *m.* John Forrester in Stirling.
5. Catherine Napier, *b.* on 8 October 1725.
