

JOHN BINNING OF DALMARNOCK, acquired the lands of Dalmarnock and died in 1708. He was father of,

1. James Binning of Dalmarnock, (*see below*).
2. Mr. Thomas Binning, who had a heritable Bond with his father, for 1300 merks Scots secured over the lands of Meikle Dalguise on 9 June 1705, and is then styled the youngest son.¹ He *dsp* by 20 August 1722 when his brother, James, was served heir general to him.²

JAMES BINNING OF DALMARNOCK, succeeded his father in 1708 and was served heir to him in the lands of Meikle Dalguise on 20 August 1722.³ He disponed his lands of Meikle Dalmarnock to Dr. John Murray, in Perth, in 1727, and *m.* Isabel, daughter of William Murray, 4th of Ardbenny, (*c/m* 23 & 27 April 1714⁴).
